Note. Unit has been stationery in this village during the whole of this month. During this time the process of demobilization has been proceeding steadily and fusion has taken place with another Unit. Current events have not been of sufficient importance to warrant a daily entry and accordingly against many dates will be found "No Entry." A record of weather has not been kept, as the weather has been uniformly bad and rain has fallen every day in the month.
