| | 20 | | At 5.40 am 1 st & 2 nd Aust Divs attacked & gained all objectives in conjunction with II Corps on the left and I Corps on the right. Several counter attacks driven off. At 3 pm eleven heavy & siege batteries commenced to move to more forward positions. Cooperation with aircraft throughout the day was most satisfactory and many calls upon bodies of hostile infantry taken on by H.A and as a result counter attacks were smashed before development. The barrages in depth proved to be most effective against the enemy dispositions in depth. (Operation Order H.A. No 6) | |



2. OVERPAINT GAUGES FOR GUNS AND HOWITZERS.

Overpaint Gauges have been approved for each nature of gun or howitzer.

It is considered that the use of these gauges is of great importance in order that the danger of prematures caused by over gauge shell may be eliminated.

Attention is therefore called to G.F.O. No: 2532 dated 29/7/17 and it should be impressed on all units that the gauging of shell is a very necessary precaution.

3. FITTING REMOVABLE VENT HEADS, OR TUBE HOLDERS, TO VENTS 'T' AXIAL.

In fitting removable vent heads, or tube holders, to vents 'T' axial, it is of the utmost importance for the point of the head to be well bedded into the copper washer. If this is not done, gas escapes past the screw thread and destroys both vent and tube holder.

Whenever the circumstances permit, tube holders should be fitted to vents in A.C.D. Workshops, but when this course cannot be followed, the Battery Fitter or the mechanic who carries out the work should first screw the vent head hard down on the washer. The vent head should then be unscrewed and the washer taken out and examined. If inspection shows that the vent head is only bearing on a portion of the washer, the part of the washer shown as bearing should be carefully scraped and the washer then annealed by making it red (dull) hot and quenching in water.

The process of scraping and annealing should be repeated until a good all-round bearing is obtained.

On no account should the point of the vent head be filed.

Only in very exceptional circumstances should Vent Heads, or Tubes Holders, be fitted by Battery Artificers. In other cases Vents should be sent in to Ordnance Workshops to be fitted and spare Vents taken into use while the work is being carried out.

1. STRIKING OFF STRENGTH.

The following extract from Second Army No: A.2528, dated May 22nd, 1917, is published for the information of, and necessary action by, all Officers concerned :-

"The following rules will be observed :-

"OFFICERS should be struck off the strength when :-

(a) Casualties in action, i.e., killed, wounded or missing (except "wounded at duty", but if an Officer reported "wounded at duty" is afterwards admitted to hospital as the result of the wound and has been so reported in the daily casualty return, he will be struck off the strength).

(b) Appointed to the Staff.

(c) Transferred to, or filling a vacancy on the authorised establishment of another unit or formation (including those accepted on probation with R.F.C. and Hvy: Branch, M.G.C.).

(d) Notified by the D.A.G. as having been evacuated sick out of the country by the medical authorities. (In the case of Machine Gun Corps Officers, they will be struck off when evacuated out of the Corps Area.).

(e) Not being Staff Officers, medically boarded or under orders for a medical board, whilst on leave in England. Also when granted "indefinite" extension of leave on Medical Certificate by the War Office when on leave in England.

(f) Attending C.O.'s. Course at Aldershot.

(g) Marked "P.B" or "P.U", or employed on the status of a "P.B" Officer under A.G.'s. authority.

Officers granted sick leave from a Base or a stationary hospital are NOT struck off strength.

Before Officers under the headings (b), (c), (d), (e) & (g) are struck off strength, the authority of the A.G., G.H.Q. must be obtained.

"OTHER RANKS should be struck off the strength when :-

(a) Casualties in action, i.e., killed, wounded and missing (except "wounded at duty").

(b) Transferred to, or filling a vacancy on the authorised establishment of another unit or formation (including those accepted on probation with the R.F.C.).

(c) Evacuated sick out of the Divisional Area (or, in the case of units not serving in Divisional Areas, when evacuated out of the Army or G.H.Q. Troops, etc. Area, as the case may be).

(d) Sentenced to imprisonment (unless sentence suspended). To have effect from date of leaving unit.

(e) Included in the 216 "attached" Infantry authorised for each Tunnelling Company.

/ (f) Candidates etc.

(f) Candidates for Commissions undergoing training away from their units.

(g) Servants who accompany their masters to C.O.'s. course at Aldershot.

(h) "Attached" Infantry authorised for Traffic Control duties.

Before other ranks under the headings (b) and (e) are struck off strength, the authority of Second Army must be obtained.

7. TRACKS - DAMAGE TO.

Reports have been received that considerable damage has been done to Light Railway Tracks by wagons and guns being pulled across the track at places unprepared for the passage of wheeled vehicles.

A.D.L.R. is prepared to make level crossings at points asked for by Corps, and owing to the necessity of getting ammunition by Light Railway to Siege Batteries, it is of the greatest importance that the track should not be damaged.

It is also reported that sleepers have been left on the line by Siege Batteries which in some cases have caused the derailling of trains of ammunition, with very serious consequences.

1. The Second Army is continuing its offensive operations with a view to the capture of the PASSE HENDAELE ridge. The Fifth Army is advancing at the same time.
2. The 1st ANZAC Corps will advance along the ridge in a N.E. direction and seize the high ground between BROODSENDE and BECELAERE.
3. The first step in this advance will be the capture of the line
J.15.d.3083 - CARLISLE FARM - J.9.d.3500 - J.9.d.27^A - J.3.d.06 ..
J.3.a.7520 - J.3.a.55 - J.3.a.28. J.3.d.20
4. The dividing line between the Right and Left Divisions of attack is a line running from J.8.c.55 to J.8.d.28 to J.8.d.69 to J.9.a.53, thence along the northern edge of POLYGOE WOOD, the road along the edge falling to the Left Division.
5. Under 1st ANZAC H.A. No.9/227 of 10th September, general instructions have already been issued to Double Bombardment Group Commanders as to the role of the Heavy Artillery in the forthcoming operations.
This role includes for five days prior to zero day:-
 - (a). Deliberate destructive fire on all known strong points, M.G. emplacements. *etc*
 - (b). Destruction of O.P.'s.
 - (c). Assisting the Divisional Artilleries by isolating fire west of the grid line North and South between Squares J.4 and 5, J.10 and 11, J.16.b. and 17.a.
East of the above line, isolating fire will be carried out under instructions from the C.B.S.O.
 - (d). Assisting the Divisional Artilleries by dealing with any approaches west of the line in (c) above.
 - (e). Assisting the Divisional Artilleries by blocking communications with 6" howitzers where necessary.
 - (f). Preliminary bombardment barrages.
These will be put down twice a day on each of the five days prior to zero.
6. On zero day a bombardment barrage will be put down by each Double B.G. Commander on his Divisional front. The details of this and the preliminary barrages will be sent to Double B.G. Commanders when the plans have been co-ordinated.
7. For the preliminary bombardment barrages and for that on zero day every available gun will be employed and in addition the batteries of the 35th and 28th H.A. Groups will be placed at the disposal of Right and Left Double B.G. Commanders respectively for this purpose.
8. For seven days prior to zero day, intense counter-battery work and isolating and harassing fire, up to the limits of ammunition allowed, will be carried out.
Separate instructions on these points and on the neutralisation of host hostile batteries will be issued by the C.B.S.O.

APPENDIX

To ensure uniformity throughout the batteries of the 1st. Anzac H.A., and to minimize the risk of destruction of ammunition by hostile fire, the following precautions will be observed :-

- (1) The following numbers of clean shell will be kept on the gun floor ready for immediate action:-

Half the above numbers will be kept ready fused, the proportion of the different natures of fuzes being fixed by Group Commanders, as circumstances dictate.

When operations of a special character are in progress the number of fused shell will be at the discretion of Group Commanders.

Indents for the special covers for fused shell should be sent in at once. Fused shell unprovided with covers should have the joint protected by a coating of mineral jelly or similar substance. Weather proof cover should be provided for all fused shell.

- (2) Shell not actually on gun floors will be kept neatly stacked in separate dumps of not more than 200-6" or 60-pdr. and in proportionate amounts for other natures. Planks will be kept under the shell in all cases and the dumps will be camouflaged adequately. Sand bag traverses will be used to isolate dumps from one another. The distance from any Cartridge dump should never be less than 15 yards. Shell will be grouped in dumps by driving bands.

- (3) The following number of cartridges will be kept on the gun floors :-

- (4) Cartridges not on the gun floors will be kept in dumps, not exceeding the following amounts :-

These dumps should in all cases have splinter proof protection and the services of the 1st. Aust. Field Coy. R.E. should be obtained by Group Commanders, to build recesses wherever possible.

Cartridges should be grouped by propellants and lot numbers as far as possible. The lids of all cylinders will always be kept securely closed.

- (5) Tubes and Fuzes will never be kept in the vicinity of Cartridges, They will be stored in a dry place, and Tubes in broken boxes should be kept oiled.

- (6) The accumulation of empty cylinders etc., tends to give away a battery position perhaps more than anything. Every opportunity should be taken to return empties of every kind as early as possible. Fuze tins, Plugs, Tube boxes etc., should be collected in separate receptacles as they become expended.
- (7) All ammunition will be unloaded as soon as it arrives and put under cover at once, due precautions against enemy aircraft being taken if the ammunition has to be unloaded by day.
- (8) Every precaution must be taken to protect detachments on the guns. Where other protection is not available, sand bag breast works will be built around guns.

Slit trenches should be prepared in the vicinity of the guns, and the services of the Field Coy., R.E. are available for the concreting of these trenches. Arrangements will be made for the supply of pumps to batteries to keep these trenches drained.
