Spare locks on the scale of one per gun or Howitzer, will be issued as soon as sufficient become available.

The greatest care should be taken that dirt, oil and grit are not allowed to accumulate in the locks, as this would have the effect of increasing the play between parts.

A considerable number of locks have been damaged through ~~running~~ their becoming clogged with mud and apparently operated when in that condition.

The locks should be changed as often as possible, one lock being dismantled, cleaned with paraffin and oiled, while the other is in action.

In no case should a lock continued to be used when, as the result of mud or dirt in the mechanism, the lever cannot be operated by the palm of the hand.

"To minimise the danger from the effects of bombs, horses will be secured in single lines, protected by a 3 feet parapet in front and behind the line".




