2. Other than local promotions which carry no ^{extra} pay, no promotions will be made without my approval. In the event of casualties occurring among the N.C.O.'s you will submit recommendations direct to me for approval.
3. Should it be found necessary to issue Part II Orders, signed copies will be sent to me for embodiment in Regimental Part II Orders.
4. In issuing local Regimental Orders, you will style yourself O.C. Detachment 2^d Australian Divisional Train
5. All casualties will be notified to me in order that vacancies may be filled from Reinforcements
6. A war diary in duplicate will be kept in accordance with para 140. Field Service Reg. Part II Reprint 1914.
7. Any special recommendations for valour, distinguished service or good work generally that you may be called upon to make to Divisional Head Quarters together with the action taken by them should be notified me for the purpose of record.
