

All brigades drew their equipment & then entrained for the concentration area of the 2nd Div. in the neighbourhood of Aire. The Divisional Ammunition column disembærked at Marseilles at the end of March & assembled at Abbeville.	
LYNDE.	31		On arrival at the concentration area AIRE a certain number of officers & men of each brigade were sent forward and attached to batteries of the 34th Div. Artillery - to learn the work & the ground.
