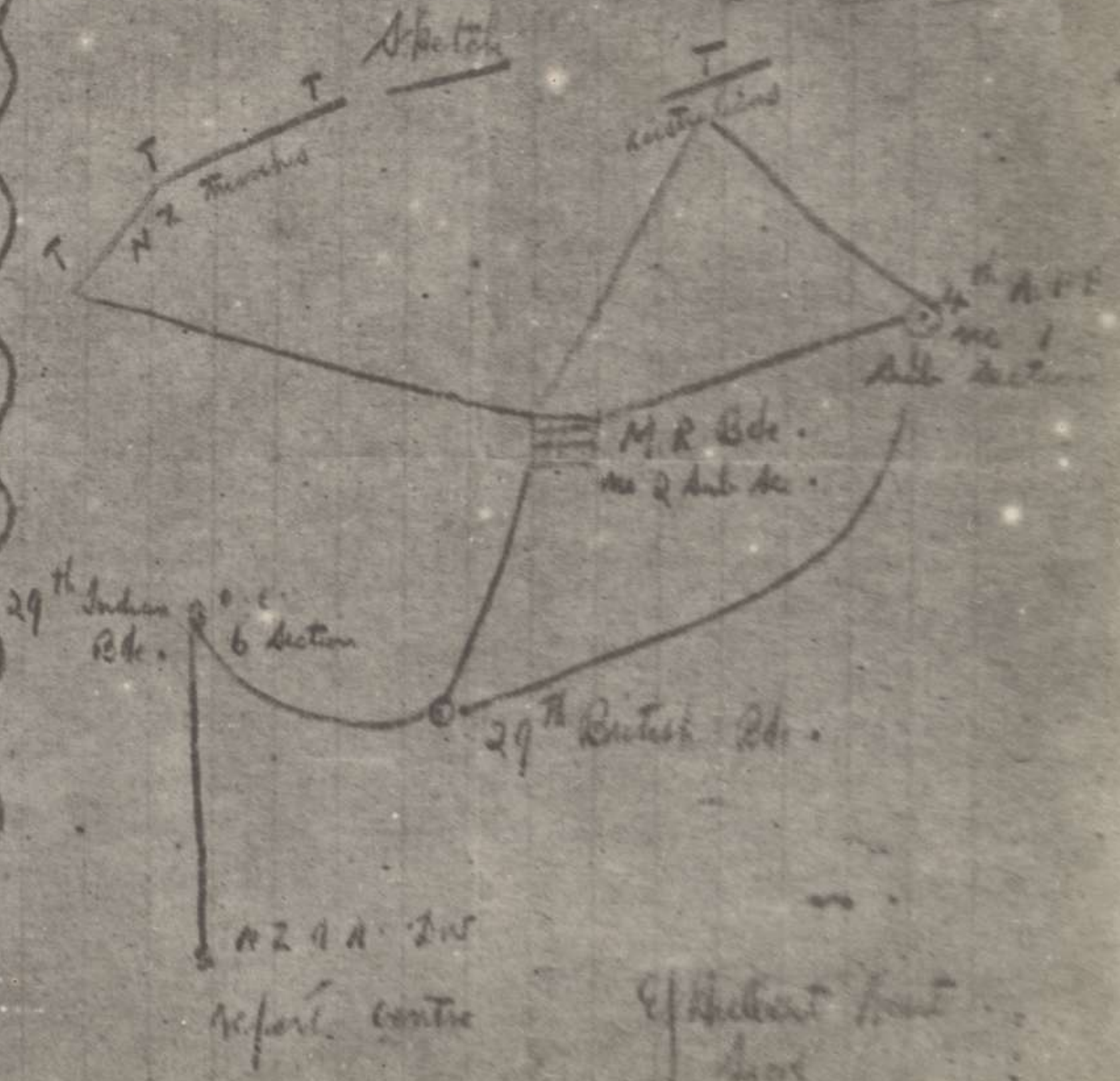

24th
Rejoined Troop middle of August.

At 4pm on this day an attack was made with the object of gaining ground on the KALASIK AGHALA HILL. The Brigade Bdrs. were moved to an advanced position during the attack & the communications were well. There were frequent attacks up to the 30th. The Mark III phone is still reliable but many Brigades are without them. There is a difficulty in obtaining new technical stores and a great shortage of wire electro v.s. also v.s.
