ESTHOF FARM	2 IX 17	10 am	Handed over to VIII Corps HA the area held till that time and went into rest at LUMBRES. Continued there till taking over the area NE of YPRES with 1st ANZAC in the south and XVIII Corps to the north	
MERTINGHE Mertinghe	28.X.17	10 am	Took over from V th Corps HA (FIFTH ARMY) after their operations on ZONNEBEKE on the 26 th inst. Lt. A. R. CHURCH was injured by aeroplane bomb several days before while attached (temp) to 1st ANZAC T.A.	
	29 X 17		Arranging position of batteries moving forward and location of groups and batteries coming into Corps from VIII, & IX Corps. Continued bombardments, counter battery work harassing tanks and support of divisions.	ZWT
