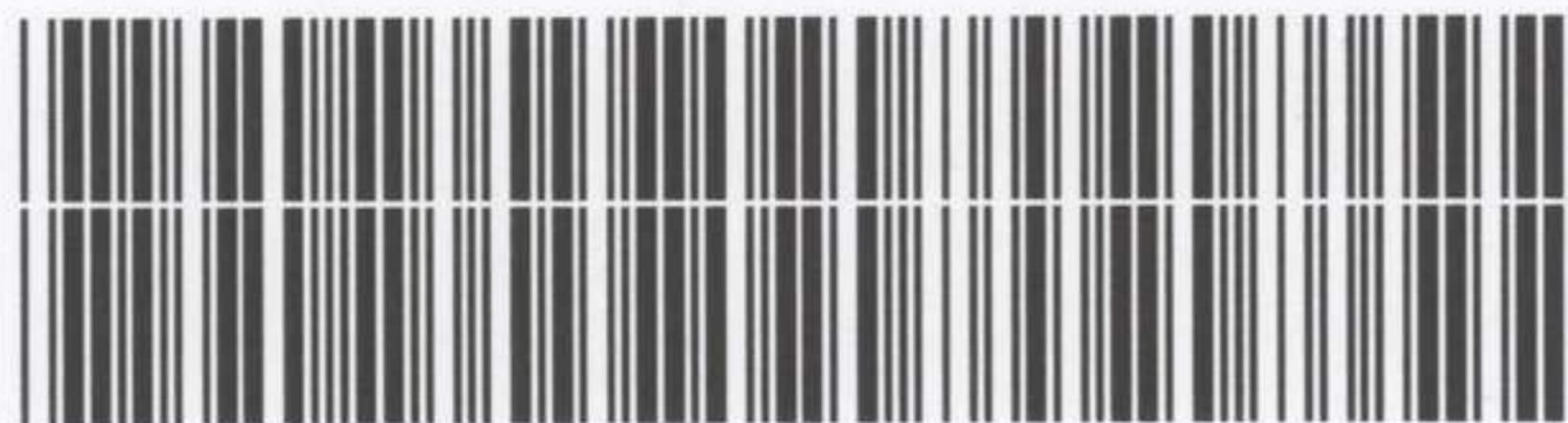

	18/2/16		Major Manning took over his duties this date. Position as S.T.O. is not satisfactory. Saw Lt. Col. Blaine, was deciding as to command since essential only one man should be responsible. Proposed to put matter before G.O.C. & have same settled. Requested to provide scheme in connection with supplies for a pursuing force.	
	19/2/16		Sent out scheme as asked for by Lt. Col. Blaine, to Div. H. Q. Picking up threads of administration here, which covers so many different matters.	
	21/2/16		Arrived at Medley to make special endeavours to forward water in order to build up Reserve at front. Pumps have not yet working owing to pumps being out of order.
