GENERAL REMARKS.

All the Regiments of the Division being now employed in the Delta or Upper Egypt the Medical Service for these Units is outside the control of this Division. Copies of all executive orders issued to Australian Medical Units by A.D.M.S., East Delta Area are however, forwarded to this office, and returns are rendered which make it possible to keep track of the sick rate of our troops and general conditions under which they are working.

The 3rd.L.H.Field Ambulance is stationed at ZAGAZIG and is doing most responsible work very efficiently.

Sick Returns show the prevailing diseases to be (a) Recurrent Malaria and (b) Venereal Disease. It is hoped that the issue of prophylactic outfits to men stationed some distance from prophylactic booths will lessen the incidence of the latter group.



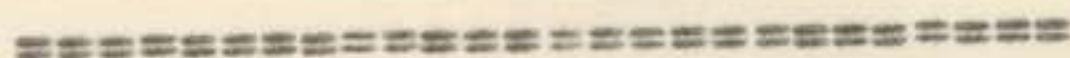

C I R C U L A R M E M O R A N D U M.

DEMOBILISATION OF A.A.M.C. OFFICERS.

In order to place the demobilisation of A.A.M.C. Officers of A.I.F. in EGYPT on a definite basis, and enable each Officer to see where he stands, it is proposed to prepare a priority list. To do this points will be allotted to each Officer as follows:-

- (1) Length of Service - 5 points for each 6 months abroad.
- (2) Age. - 1 point for each year over 40.
- (3) Dependants. - 10 points for 1 dependant and 5 for each additional, total not to exceed 25 points.
- (4) Other Reasons. - Not to exceed 25 points.
- (5) Penalties. - not to exceed 25 points.

C.Os. will prepare and forward immediately through A.Ds.M.S. a return for each Officer under their command showing:-

- (a) What points he is entitled to under paras 1, 2, and 3.
- (b) What points they recommend under para 4, stating reasons as briefly as possible.
- (c) What penalty they recommend under para 5.

A.Ds.M.S. will make their recommendations and forward to D.D.M.S., A.I.F. in EGYPT who will make the final allotment of points under paras 4 and 5.

Penalties. These will apply principally to Officers holding commands and Staff appointments. A penalty may be imposed up to 25 points for indispensibility and recent promotion. An Officer holding an important appointment which is not understudied will be penalised accordingly, but, if he is understudied, part or whole of the penalty may be transferred to the understudy. When the need for the appointment for which he is penalised ceases to exist, the penalty will be removed and his place on the list altered accordingly.

The list will be made available as soon as completed, and will be adhered to as far as the exigencies of the service will allow.

(4) SANITATION. Owing to the moving out of troops the sanitation of the Divisional area is not as satisfactory as it might be; incinerators and horse lines being left in a condition conducive to fly breeding. The lines of Units which are stationary are improving slowly. More attention should be paid however to the carting away of incinerated material and to the protection of food and waste against flies which in many cases have free access. permission is being sought from P.L. of C. to have showers erected in the area for the use of troops.

(5) GENERAL. Regiments are dispersed widely through Delta and in Upper Egypt. Appreciations of Medical situation by each R.M.O. have reached this office and show that things Medical are satisfactory. All are alive to the danger of Malaria and Bilharzia and each has a prophylactic outfit. Nominally the troops of this Division are administered by either :-


