

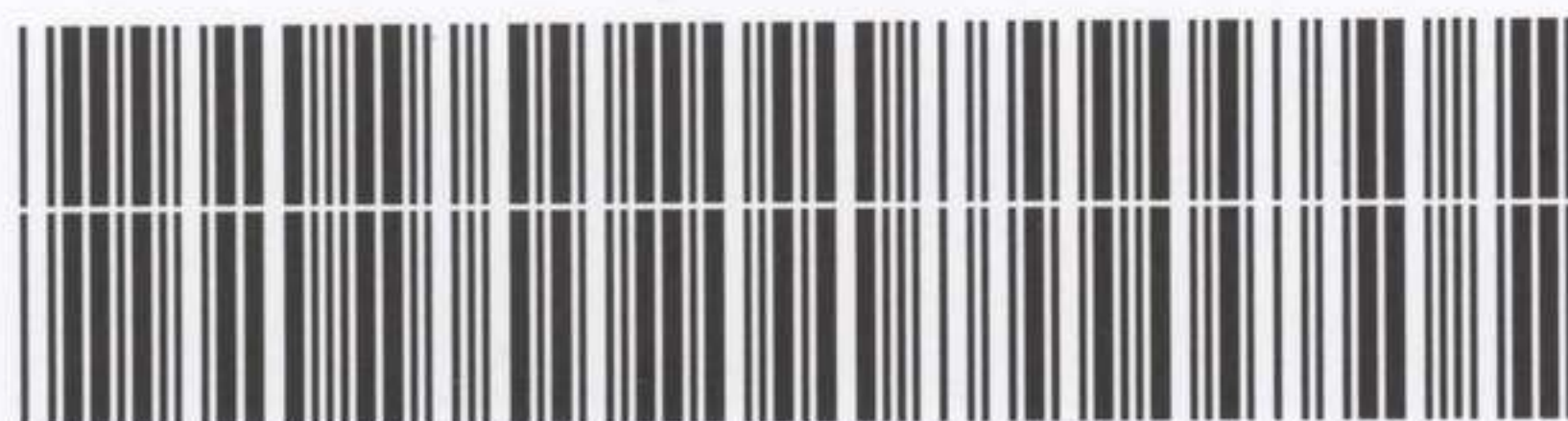

Cpl Evans & Pte Williams proceeded to Belah with Shaft for "Thresh" Disinfector & fitted same. Delousing natives of Field Ambulances (87) Disinfected 100 blankets from Amzac Receiving Station

O.C. inspected N.Z. Brigade & Anti Air-Craft Gun Section

O.C. Inspected area vacated by 1st A.L.H. Brigade. L/Cpl Worthington sent to RAFA to take charge of Dump. L/Cpls Smout & Jones to Port Said Rest Camp. Pte Swan relieving L/Cpl Smout 2nd Bgde Pte Anderson relieving L/Cpl Jones at 1st Brigade.

Deloused 12 natives attached to 2nd Brigade for Sanitary duties, also Two natives attached Sig Corps Desert Mounted Corps for sanitary duties.

Cpl Evans & Pte Eager with 4 natives buried dead horse reported by A.P.M. 400 yards west of Aerodrome. Drew "Fly deterrent" from A.S.C.

Deloused 17 natives from N.Z. amb. (11 Sanitary & 6 Camel natives). O.C. inspected 2nd Bgde Ptes Hunt & French returned from Pt Said Rest Camp.

Pte Hunt in charge of 2 natives burnt large quantity of manure (left by a previous Brigade) 400 yards South East of Y.M.C.A. O.C. inspected D.W. units. Received charge sheet against native No charged with selling his mate's rations. Found guilty and awarded 10 lashes.

Deloused 250 natives from Divisional train

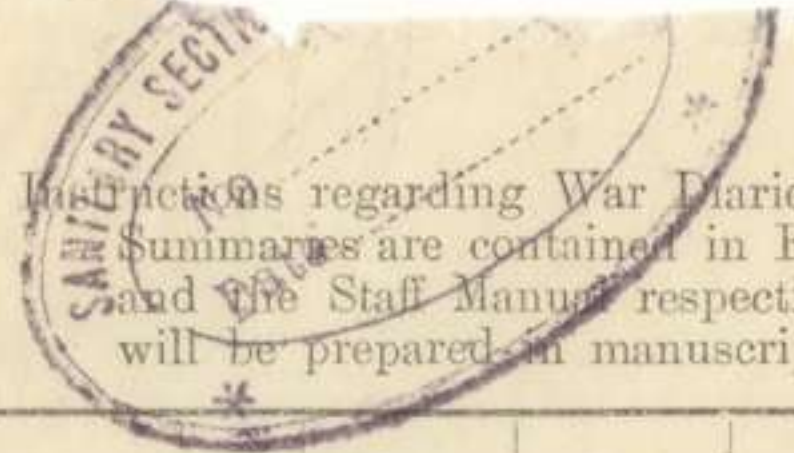

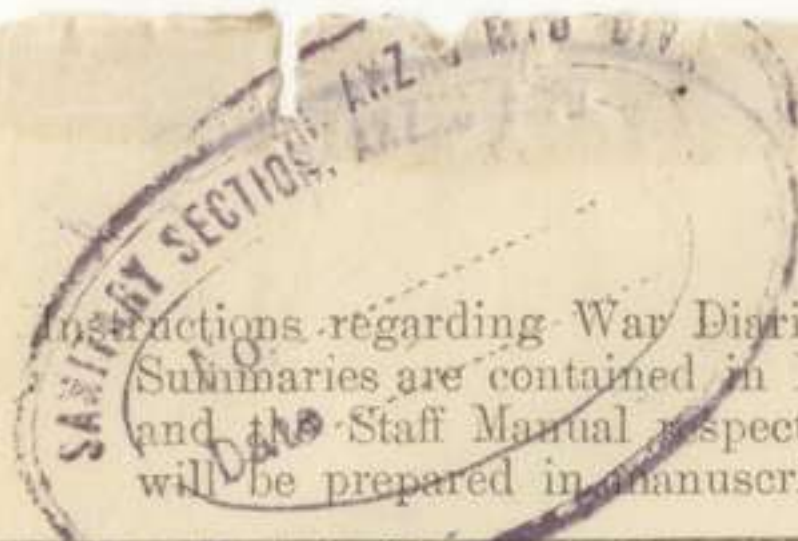

L.S.M.	10.		Pte Stack posted as Inspector to 7 th Yeomanry Brigade also 4 natives for Sanitary duty. Ptes Farley + Gibson out burning rubbish near Railway line.	
L.S.M.	11.		Inspected Div. Train, Anti Air Craft Gun Section, Wellington + Canterbury manure spreads. Withdrew one native each from 1 st + 2 nd Brigades for duty at 7 th Yeomanry Brigade. Cpl Evans inspected 1 st Brigade on the beach and found camp area in good order.	
L.S.M.	12.		Posted 7 natives to 7 th Mtd Brigade for Sanitary duty. Ptes Harrington + Harrison to Port Said Rest Camp. S. Sgt inspected areas adjacent to N.Z. + 2 nd Brigades	
L.S.M.	13.		L/Cpls Smout + Jones returned from Pt Said Rest Camp. Capt Fitzhardinge inspected 7 th Mtd Bde + Watering Area at Kilo 9. A.B.C. Batteries of 74 th Division moved into + camped next our Divisional Train. Pte Carmichael, inspector at Div. Train, instructed to inspect these Batteries whilst they are camped in this area. Issued Fly deterrents to 7 th Mtd Brigade + Batteries.	
L.S.M.	14.		Pte Swan posted to 7 th Mtd Bde as inspector. Camped in Area West of Divisional Train. found everything very satisfactory. S. Sgt inspected Batteries of 74 th Div. Also inspected Divisional Train +

C.S.M.	18.		O.C. + Ssgt. inspected Abasan Watering Area also Anti-Aircraft Gun Section.	
C.S.M.	19.		Ssgt. inspected 7 th Btd Brigade also Westminster Dragoons (1 Regt att 20 th Army Corps Hqrs) camped 400 Yards East of Watering Area Fukhari.	
C.S.M.	20.		Cpl Fraser proceeded to Shellal Jctn in charge of 'Thresh' disinfecter. Team supplied by N.Z.M.F. Amb. natives attached 7 th Bgde returned to Camp.	
C.S.M.	22 nd		Ptes Harrington + Harrison returned from Pt Said Rest Camp. Ptes Hunt + Gibson in charge of native gang out cleaning up Camp Area vacated by 2 nd Bgde. Ssgt. Williams proceeded to Shellal Jctn to inspect Dump + make arrangements for Section to move.	
C.S.M.	23.		Ptes Hunt, Gibson + Farley with natives continued the work of cleaning up camp area vacated by 2 nd Bgde. Cpl Evans with Pte Anderson + 4 natives buried a mule, reported by M.O. Westminster Dragoons, lying about 500 yards East of their Camp close to Railway line. Loaned G.S. Wagon + team to N.Z. Amb to take loads to Shellal Junction. Ssgt. inspected Abasan Watering Area.	
C.S.M.	24		Work of cleaning up Camp vacated by units proceeded with. Posted 1 native to Des Cox's Field Laboratory. Pte Finch returned to Camp with natives from 2 nd Brigade.

FUKHARI 18th	25.		Work of party proceeded as in yesterday's entry. Capt Evans + Plt Carmichael with natives buried camel reported by our inspector between crossing on wire road No 15 + 16 (Abasan - Fukhari Road). Loaned team to assist Amyar Immobile Section for Amb. to move to Gambo.	
18th	26.		Work party engaged cleaning up Camp areas vacated by Div. Train, Receiving Station + Batteries. 3 natives attached D.H. Am. + 1 attached to Des. Mtd Corps returned to Camp.	
18th	27.		Mobile Section moved to Shellal Junction. Immobile Section + natives left behind to continue work of cleaning up Camp Areas.	
Shellal Junction 18th	28.		Immobile Section Arrived at Shellal Junction from Fukhari + reported to Mobile Section and reported all Camp Areas Clean + manure mostly burnt + only a small amount (damp + not inflammable) left which was raked out very thin.
