"	25/2/17	1.30 am.	Orders received from 1st A.N.Z.A.C. Mounted Troops to concentrate one Company at MILLENCOURT at once, on account of retirement of the Enemy. It was decided that A Company should concentrate, and approval was given for the withdrawal of personnel from Traffic Control to complete Company. 12 noon 2/lieut. White J.G. W. reported for duty from Base and was taken on the strength of A Company.	
"	26/2/17	8 am.	Advised 1st A.N.Z.A.C. and 1st A.N.Z.A.C. Mounted Troops, that A Company complete and ready for action at MILLENCOURT. lieut. W. Ross. in command.	
"	28/2/17		Battalion Strength as at February 28th 1917 as follows:- Officers 19 Other ranks 447. On detached duties. Officers 3 Other ranks 266, (excluding A Company mobilised).
