LARK HILL	1/10/16	11pm	Inspected Bivouac site partially + tested water supply	
-	2/10/16	10.30 pm	Went out to Bivouac area + selected sites for dressing stations - main + 2 Advanced. Sent B Section out + issued admic orders as S.M.O. B'de. The B'de Hoop. in LARK HILL to represent a Div. Rest Station. Have also issued Circulars on Sanitation + gas protection. Shifted Camp from No. 21. to No. 3. with rest of unit. Much delay + difficulty due to lack of horses + very wet day.	
	3/10/16	10pm	Inspected Bivouac + commenced drafting Standing Orders for unit Brigade Admic Orders No. 3 issued to-night + No. 2 sent this morning with Circ Memoranda on Sanitation + Gas Protection.	
	4/10/16	9.30 pm	Morning occupied with routine (inspections + orderly room work). In afternoon inspected units bivouac. Advised Brigadier to break camp owing to weather conditions. He concurred + marched Brigade into LARK HILL this evening.	
	5/10/16	10pm	Ordinary Routine Training. Completed Standing Orders for unit.	
	8/10/16		On weekend leave returned to-night.
