War Diary Signal Troop NZM R Bde July 1916

July 14
21 First information of Turkish advance.
NZM R Bde strengthened by addition of 5th LH Regt (Queidan) Warwuch Yeo.
as composite regt of Iphastia or Worcester Yeomanry. The whole force being designated
"Section Mounted Troops" to Section Canal Defences. Active patrolling was
carried out south & south east from DUEIDAR. Permanent night ^{day} posts
