Somme	1/11/16		Bearer Division complete reported for duty at Corps Rest Station, Buire. Tent Sub-Divisions running the Corps Collecting Station, Becordel.		
"	9/11/16		Bearer Division relieved of duties at Corps Rest Station and proceeded to Thistle Dump and attached to 6th Australian Field Ambulance for duty in front area. 1 Ambulance Wagon, Water Cart and 4 Daimler Motor Ambulances also attached to 6th Aust.Fd.Ambulce together with 26 horses - 20 of which were used for sleighs.		
"	22/11/16		Bearer Division reported to C. Collecting Station from front area. During the month this Collecting Station has been visited weekly by the D.D.M.S. & D.A.D.M.S. 1st Anzac, 10,524 patients have passed through sick and wounded since the 31st October. Everything has worked satisfactory, therefore there is little to report on.
