Awarae	Sep 11 <sup>th</sup>	1800	Lt. Col. Giblin evacuated to Base suffering from Cardiac dilatation & Dysentery Evacuations for 24 hours 176
	Sep 12 <sup>th</sup>	1800	Evacuations 151. Col Corkery 16 <sup>th</sup> CCS acting as Medical Control Officer
	Sep 13 <sup>th</sup>	1800	Evacuations 194. E. J. Kirk transferred from 6 <sup>th</sup> Ball. on our strength from Sep 11 <sup>th</sup> L. Sgt James evacuated to Mudros suffering from Gastro Enteritis. 20 Bell tents arrived from Mudros & stored here. 20 Marquee tents sent to 13 <sup>th</sup> Clearing C.S. to store for us.
	Sep 14 <sup>th</sup>	1800	Evacuations 193 Pte Gould evacuated to Mudros with Gastro Enteritis. Navy refused evacuation in afternoon due to heavy weather.
	Sep 15 <sup>th</sup>	1800	Evacuations 232. Gen Bonell D.M.S. came on shore sent word that he was calling on us but did not come. A few shells on beach from Right, no damage done. Col Corkery called. Note re Emeline & Antitetanic serum received & noted.
	Sep 16 <sup>th</sup>	1800	Evacuations 130. Pte Merchant evacuated to Mudros suffering from Dysentery
	Sep 17 <sup>th</sup>	1800	Evacuations 159
	Sep 18 <sup>th</sup>	1800	Evacuations 97. Capt H. I. Carlike evacuated to Base suffering from Pyrexia. Pte E. J. White to Base with Dysentery. Letter from D.M.S. M.C. ordering all wounded & severely sick to be marked Hospital Ship. Light sick cases marked Fleet Sweeper to Hospital at Imbros. Fleet Sweeper at present arrives 2100 & leaves at 0700 for Mudros. Pte Walker rejoined unit. Letter from Capt Barton saying he is at Mudros with Capt Moody & 30 reinforcements for us

	Sept 10	1800	Evacuations 113. Plts Pearcell + Cosgrove reinforcements arrived. Inspected sites with Col House + Dms for Hospital on North Beach.	
	Sept 11	1800	Evacuations <del>47</del> 47. Pte Walker evacuated to Hospital ship suffering from Venereal disease (Chancres). Col House. En Cauntus + En Williams decided site for Hospital + commenced work with 10 men clearing ground.	
	Sept 12	1800	Plt P In previous 24 hours only 1 patient evacuated which was a serious abdominal case. H.M.T Gascon sent word that she was full + could take no more patients. At present over 100 patients are waiting evacuation. Hospital ship stated by Naval Officer to be leaving Mudros P.M. + could give no idea of time of arrival.	
	Sept 13	1800	Evacuations 228. Fuel low at 0900.	
	Sept 14	1500	Evacuations 133 Corp. Kuttin evacuated to Hospital ship suffering from Dysentery
