

HEADQUARTERS, 11th June 1917.

- 1. ORDER NO. 74 IS CANCELLED.
- 2. The Divisional Front from noon 12th instant will extend from the BLAWEPOORT BEEK to the River DOUVE, both inclusive.
- As from 12 noon, 12th instant, the Artillery covering the front will be grouped by Brigades.
