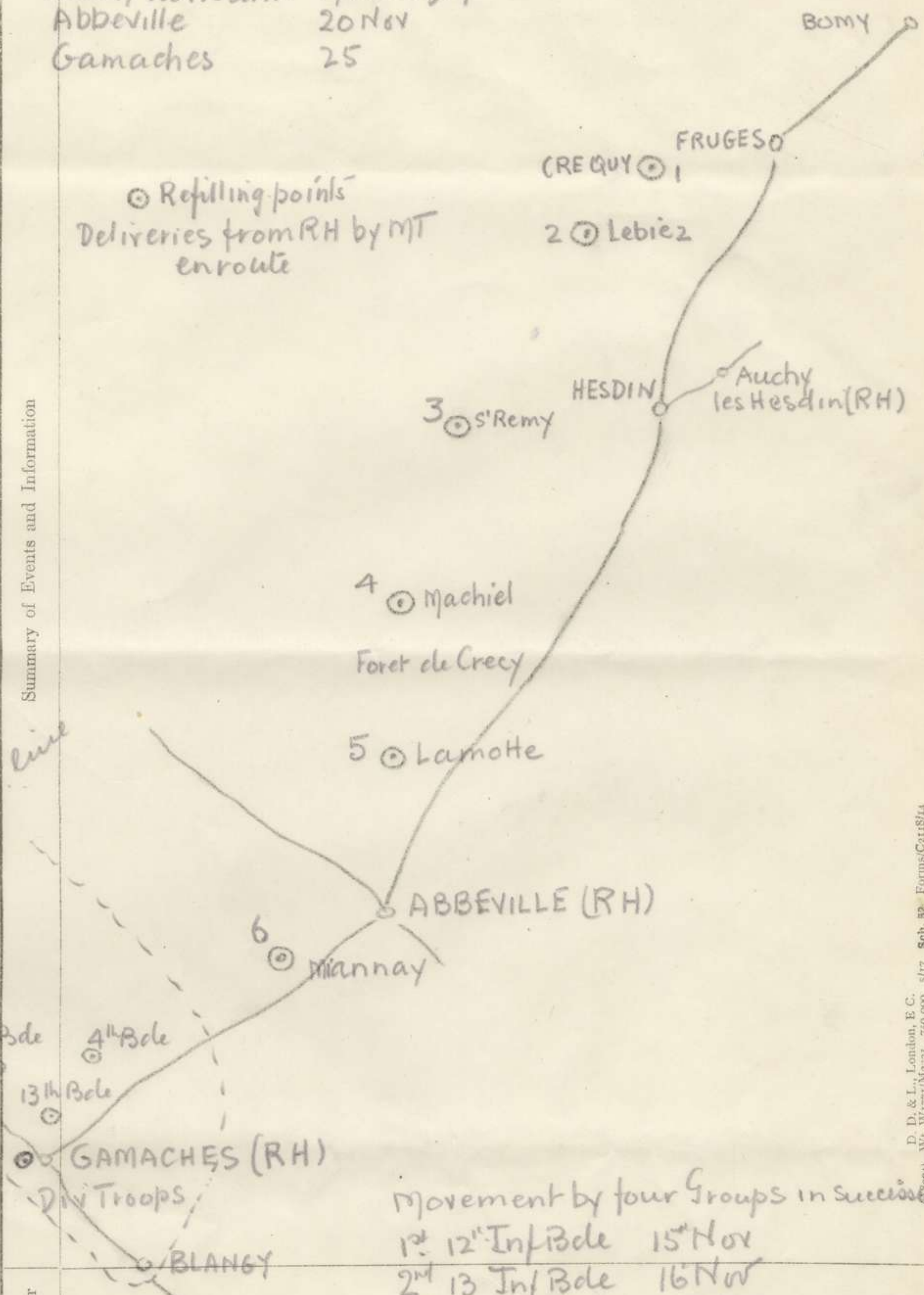

Peronne III Army (Reserve Division)	Dec 21 st	<p>as showing the position of Infantry Bdes when ordered to move. The following is interesting - The 4th and 13th Bdes changed over camps. On the 20th the following units moved. Bde Hdqrs. M G Coy Light T. M Battery 49th and 50th Bns moved to Moislans - No supplies were carried across country leaving supply vehicles available for baggage purposes. 15 G Swagons were required to move above and of these 6 G Swagons did two trips this equals 21 loads - Actual allowance of transport from the Train would be five G Swagons - This is given as an example of deficiency in H. Transport - When the Division moves at other times Motor Lorries carry this surplus baggage - The War Office makes no provision for Train vehicles carrying Blankets - One G Swagon is required for each 400 Blankets - Should the Division be required to move at the rate of 15 miles per day for a week the first day would mean the shedding of much stores and baggage - anything surplus now being carried is in the interests and comfort of the men -</p> <p>The above example is typical of the Division or of most Divisions and the assumption is that the War Office do not provide blanket wagons but expect H.
