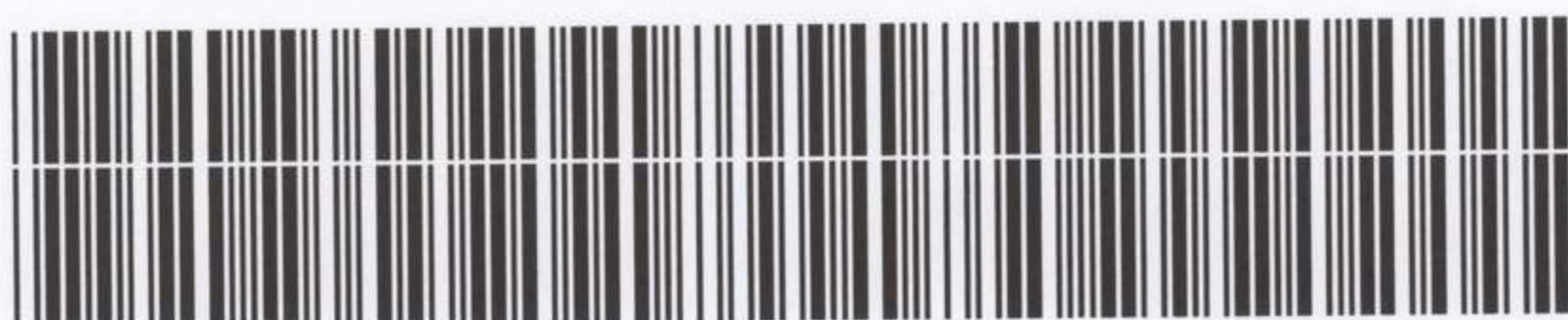

Field Ambulances the total personnel is 4 officers and 79 O/Ranks 52 horses 100 mules 21 donkeys which required almost half the personnel for their attention. The actual number available for nursing duties are 2 A.C.O.s and 8 O/Rs. The rest being employed in (1) Dressing Tent (2) Receiving Tent (3) Orderly Room @ Stretcher Bearing (4) General Duties.
