By Major R.F. FITZ-GERALD, D.S.O., Commanding AUSTRALIAN CORPS CYCLIST BATTN.

A reconnaissance scheme by Coys. will be carried out tomorrow morning. Coys. will work independently but will keep touch.

It is required to make good the MONTBREHAIN - JONCOURT Road by 1130 and Coys. will be in position as follows ready to move forward at 0945 :-

"C" Coy. at X Roads N. of FONTAINE-UTERTE, "B" Coy. SEQUEHART and "A" Coy. LEVERGIES.

Troops will move forward in bounds securing any high ground and making good such positions before moving again. Selected scouts will be used and messages sent regularly to Company Comdrs.

Villages, woods etc., will be searched for any enemy troops, where necessary reconnaissance being made dismounted. The attitude of the inhabitants towards our troops to be noted and reported regularly, also approximate quantities of fodder in sight.

Reports will also be furnished as to numbers of enemy guns, M.G.'s and T.M.'s etc., left behind with locations.

Battalion H.Q.'rs will be (nominally) at the South end of RAMICOURT village - at the close of operations moving to that position direct from SEQUEHART.

At 1130 "C" Coy. should hold MONTBREHAIN and the high ground to the North, "B" Coy. RAMICOURT and the hill to the West, "A" Coy. JONCOURT and the high ground to the North and North West. Scouts from "B" Coy. should then be in WIANCOURT and scouts from "A" Coy. in ESTREES.

After the operation all messages will be handed in to Orderly Room.

Previous to the operation this order will be read out to all troops.

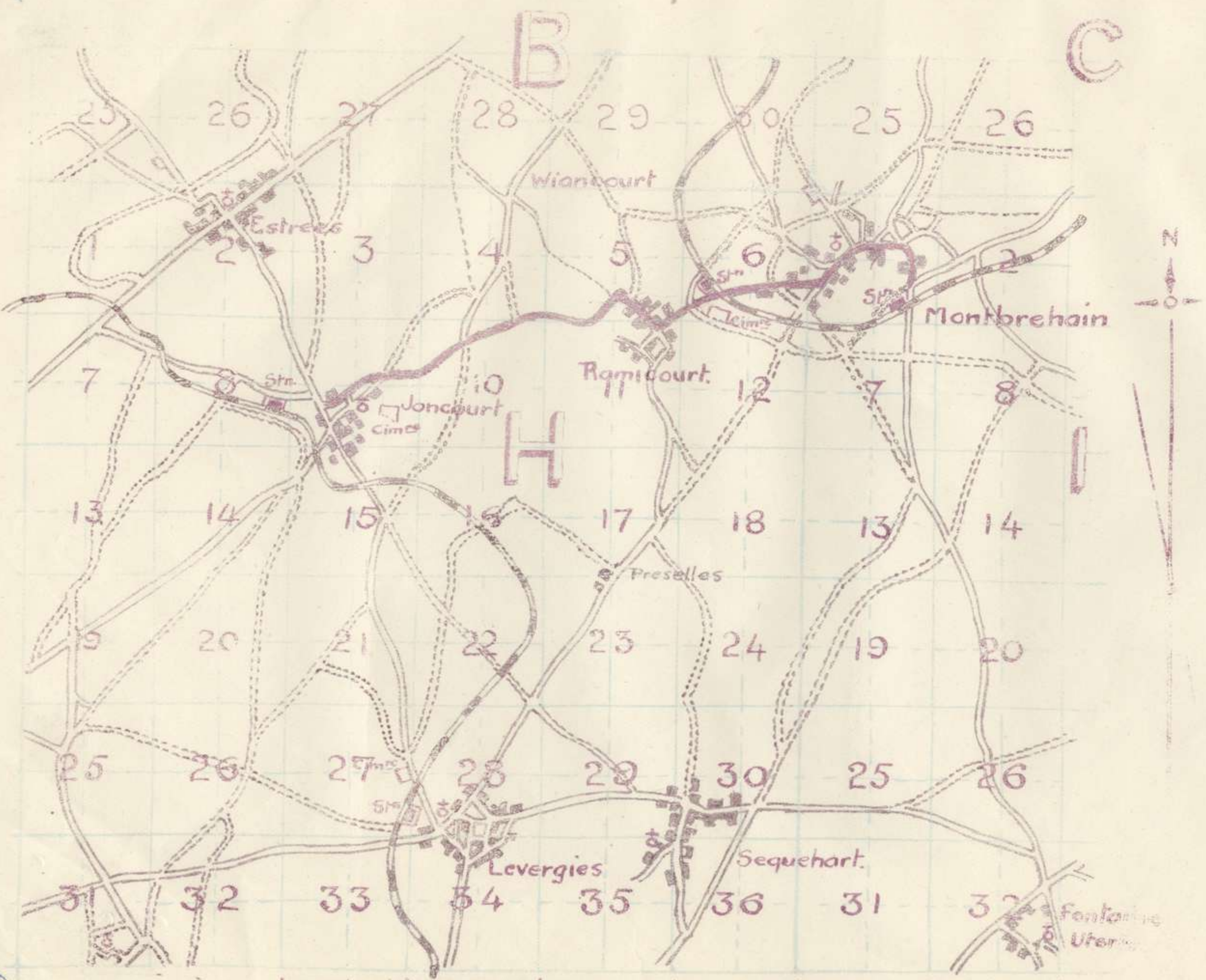
In view of the early possibility of similar operations in enemy country, the necessity for paying the strictest attention to every detail cannot be too strongly impressed on all ranks.

Parade with cycles. Dress, fighting order (less rations). 2 Lewis guns per Coy. to be carried.
