



Three (3) Motor Ambulance Cars will convey the equipment necessary for the Advance Party proceeding to hold D.R.S. at QUEHEN and will leave present position before 10 a.m. 13-12-17, conveying same to D.R.S. QUEHEN and handing over to Staff Sergeant Berry of this Unit. They will then proceed to the Railway Station, DESVRES and report to Officer i/c Advance Party at 1800, 13-12-17, and convey the Advance Party to QUEHEN. Approval was sought and obtained from A.D.M.S., 5th Aust. Division, to find further accommodation for the personnel and to transfer the patients in the D.R.S. to permanent buildings, owing to the state of the weather and the time of year. 2 (two) Barns were obtained in an adjoining farm sufficient to accommodate 100 (one hundred) of the personnel who were accordingly moved there, the patients beingthen transferred from the tents to the permanent buildings.
