

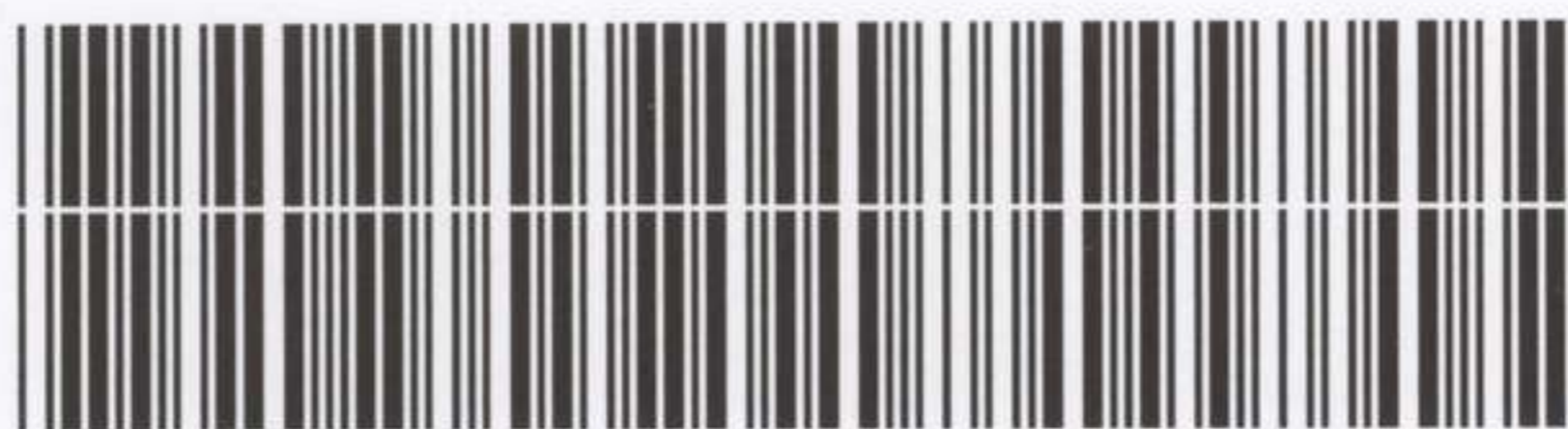

	15/2/18		The A.D.M.S., A.I.F., in Egypt visited the hospital. 264 invalids were discharged to ambulance train in Port Said for embarkation at Suez on the H.M.T. "Ulysses" to Australia.	
	28/2/18		The Inspector, Palestine Lines of Communication, (General Broadbent) visited the hospital and agreed to the putting in of a number of new works previously asked for to increase the efficiency of the unit. Provisions are well in hand for the providing of amusement, recreation and sports of the patients and staff. Herewith summary of statistics.
