- 26.1.19 Major C. Robbins left for bus. today Lt. McNAMARA took over Command of 29th Co. First heavy fall of snow the winter. JMS
- 28.1.19 Remount Board finished classifying horses of the Train. Intp. Dobosca transported to French Mission at D.H.Q. JMS
- 31.1.19 181 28 Bⁿ from Wing 14 to 16 Co & 18th to 28th Co all privates. During the month weather conditions have been bad. The Road since 24th being frozen making the delivery of Supplies difficult. All the Horses have been shod with foot shoes & foot caps inserted but the same experience as happened last winter foot caps being too long & easily broken off. The Supplies with the exception of Vegetables & Jam are good & full issue. Base reports unable to procure vegetables. JMS
