WAR DIARY FOR MONTH OF MARCH 1919

Owing to the commencement of demobilisation of the division, the technical classes languished and on the 10th of the month preparations were begun to hand in the stores of the unit to D A D O S all classes therefore being broken up. The packing and cleaning of stores together with their checking up, kept the company strength busily employed, until the 19th when all was complete.

On the 19th Company Headquarters moved to RAMBURELLES concentrating with the 11th Field Company.

On the 20th Stores were handed into D A D O S the handing over being completed on the 21st when the remainder of the company came to RAMBURELLES and joined the 11th Aust Infantry Brigade Demobilisation Regiment.

From this date to the end of the month ordinary routine work was carried out, the numbers gradually dwindling owing to men leaving to NON-MILITARY EMPLOYMENT. Daily parades were held but the men had the afternoons entirely free. By the 29th of the month all horses but one had been evacuated and the company itself was just waiting for its orders to move out in quotas.
