

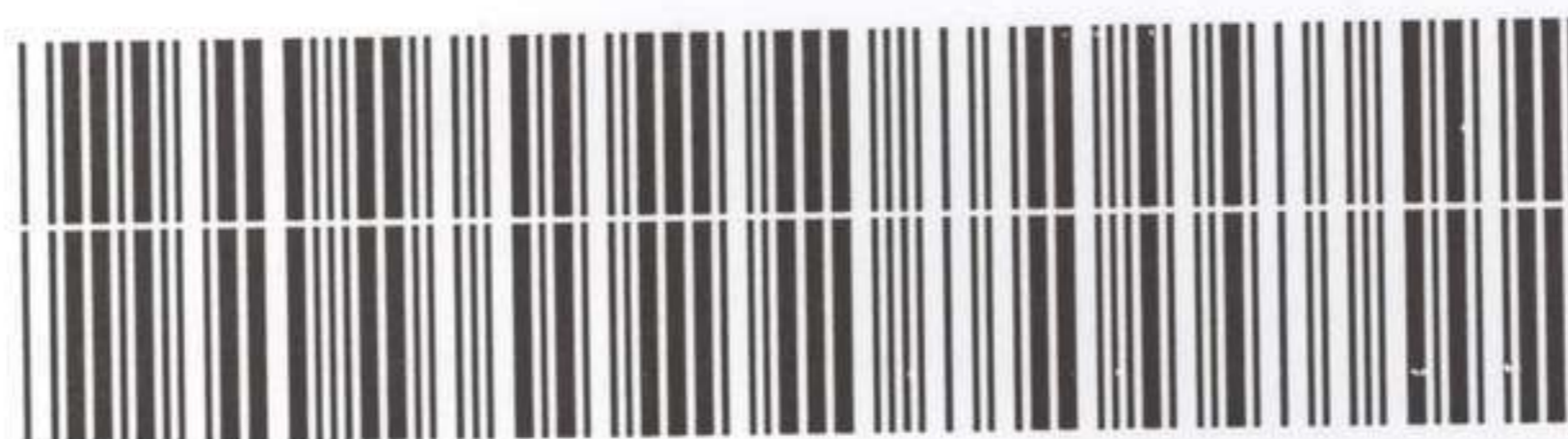

Nov-26 th	5. AM	Arrived off Aden anchored at 8 miles.	
Nov-26 th	7. AM	Moved off from Aden.	
Nov-28 th		Received wireless informing us we were to go to Egypt for training.
