6/8/15	POPES RESERVE GULLY. 11 to 12 m	'A' Squadron and 2 troops of 'B' Squadron came down from POPES POST yesterday evening and joined the regiment in reserve. Attack on Turkish position commenced today at 5.30 p.m. by Australian Division on right of line. Lt. A. L. H. Bode holding POPES + QUINN'S POSTS, and to attack trenches in front of those positions at 4.30 a.m. tomorrow. This Regiment detailed as Brigade Reserve. Lieut. Barnett and <del>112</del> <sup>112</sup> men, mainly reinforcements arrived from HELIOPOLIS today. Strength of Regt. now 14 officers 358 O.R.	vide appendix 8. operation order no. 1. J. L. H.

7/8/15	POPES RESERVE GULLY 6 PM	The Regiment (less 2 Squadrons) returned to bivouac at 2 p. m. today. C. Squadron went to QUINN'S POST to reinforce that position, held by 2nd A.L.H. B. Squadron went to POPES POST to take over 'C' (left) subsection of the post. Neither the 1st. nor 2nd L.H. were successful in their attempt to take the Turkish trenches. The 1st. A.L.H. held the trenches they got into for 2 hours and then had to retire. The 2nd A.L.H. never got to their objective, owing to heavy flanking and enfilade machinegun fire.
