2. Equipment and kits and Guard of X, Y, Z and V 4 A Batteries will be sent in four lorries leaving their Camp at 8 a.m.. The personnel of these Batteries will proceed by March Route at such time on the 14th as the D.T.M.O. may order. A guide for the lorries will be at D.A.H.Q. at 7.45 a.m..
3. Distances of 200 yards will be maintained between Batteries and Sections of the D.A.C. and at least 500 yards between Brigades.
4. Owing to the shortage of horses, no men are to ride on the vehicles, except the driver, and brakesman in the case of G.S. Wagons.
5. Transport of Brigades and D.A.C. will march in rear of each Brigade and the D.A.C. with necessary baggage guard under the command of an Officer.
6. All echelons will march filled. A statement showing the amount and nature of ammunition "marching out" will be prepared by Brigades and D.A.C. and handed to Staff Captain immediately on arrival at detraining station.
7. Advance parties for each Brigade and the D.A.C. will be sent in advance on the 14th instant, to take over Camps.
8. Supply arrangements will be notified later.

Units march with rations for 14th with them. Rations 15th will be delivered in new Camp; thereafter till entraining, usual routine drawing at E 5 Central. Extra forage wagons as laid down in War Establishment, will entrain with Brigades and will be distributed by O.C., 14th Company A.A.S.C. in time to entrain at the entraining Station.
