Men & officers were worked fairly hard 9 & 10 R.H. taking turn about in trenches until finally relieved by Northampton Bt. when the Regt moved to Rhododendron Spur arriving at 10-30 pm on the evening of 8th inst. Regt moved further up slope of hill & made dugouts. Working parties were at once instituted for trench digging making ^{for} observation posts whilst large parties worked
