

aison rce H.Q eet 62D 40,000. 22.d.2.2	12		Liaison Force took over command of Sector, North Bank of Somme to L.S.central at 5 p.m. Issued A.A.M.C. Order No. 1, copies attached. See appendix No. 1 Visited 13th Aust. Field Ambulance H.Q. 62D/J.28.c.9.8. Issued Amendment to A.A.M.C. Order No. 1, copies attached. See appendix 1a. Issued A.A.M.C. Order No. 2, copies attached. 	13.	11.30 a.m.	Successful operation carried out last night by 13th Aust. Brigade in which they occupied squares Q.26 and 32, Sheet 62D, and line now runs along Northern Bank of Somme to outskirts of BRAY. 1 officer and 180 other ranks taken prisoner with only 5 wounded as casualties in 13th Brigade. Left flank of Division South of river Somme now protected. D.D.M.S. Aust. Corps called and gave instructions that he would shortly be withdrawing "A" and "C" Sections of 129th Provisional Field Ambulance, U.S.A., and also 2 Sunbeam cars for duty elsewhere.					
			Acting D.A.D.M.S. visited A.D.M.S. 17th Division, which relieved 3rd Aust. Division on our right last night, to make arrangements with him that casualties from this Sector should pass through the M.D.S. near HAMEL, thus shortening the distance that our Divisional cars have been covering while evacuating to FOUILLOY. Walking Wounded Dressing Station is to be established at SAILLY-le-SEC by noon today by 13th Aust. Field Ambulance, and cases will then be evacuated by them direct to C.C.S. VECQUEMONT by busses. 6 busses reported to W.W. Dressing Station. Issued A.A.M.C. Order No. 3, copies attached, see appendix 3. "A" & "C" Sections 129th Prov. Field Ambulance moved to M.D.S. VILLERS-BRETONNEUX.	Kags.				
	14.		Visited R.A.Ps. of 49th, 50th & 51st Battalions. R.A.P. 50th Bn. is not in a good spot as a considerable amount of gas still hangs about the quarry, and R.A.P. is not even splinter-proof. Advised R.M.O. to move to quarry at K.24.d. Considerable number of dead Germans and horses still unburied. It was arranged for "B" Section 129th Prov. Field Ambulance to open D.C.S. at Smiths Farm, I.30.b.3.5. to hold some slight cases. Issued Medical Arrangements as at 6 p.m. 14/8/18, copies attached, see appendix 4.	A

iaison Force H.Q. heet 62D /40,000. .22.d.2.2.	17.	American Field Ambulance. Also visited A.D.M.S. 47th Division at HEILLY. D.A.D.M.S. visited 13th Aust. Field Ambulance and Regimental Surgeon of 131st American Infantry Brigade, also A.D.S. at SAILLY LAURETTE, and found that cars could get over bridge to GAILLY on way to HAMEL M.D.S. D.D.M.S. Aust. Corps visited the office and arranged that am Main Dressing Station for stretcher cases should be opened at noon on 18th instant at 1.30.b.3.5. ISSUED A.A.D.M.S. visited three battalions of 131st American Inf. Regt. to investigate the number of cases evacuated gassed as a considerable number of these are reaching the A.D.S. and Showed no symptoms. The reason was due to an order which R.M.Os. said came from the American Gas Officer that any man who reported that he was gassed had to be evacuated whether he showed any symptoms or not. Advised that some revision of this order should be made so as to reduce the number of evacuations due to this. Also advised that some supervision over sanitation be made by them at once as this is in a very unsatisfactory condition. M.D.S. opened at 1.30.b.3.5. at twelve noon, all stretcher cases from Liaison Force being evacuated through this station instead of through HAMEL M.D.S. A.D.M.S. visited N.D.S. at 1.30.b.3.5.; found accommodation poor but sufficient for quiet warfare arranged with "Q" Liaison Force for a loading party to assist. Also arranged to send another operating tent from H.Q. 13th Field Amb. to store cases. A.D.M.S. and D.A.D.M.S. visited its and Srd Bns. 13ist American Inf. Regt. to find out what steps had been taken with regard to sanitation. As far as we could find out no action had been taken. The situation was once sgain explained to them; they stated that they had considerable difficulty in getting anything done in the matter by their Pns. A stock of latrine seate has been waiting for them at 13th Field Coy. Engineers dump for 48 hours. They have been notified on several occasions that they were there. APPENDIX Leaison Force Lo: Headquartero (Q) Linison Fonce Sanitation - SAILLY-LAURETTE & SAILLY-LE-SEC On inspection of these towns it was found that although filled with debris from bombardment, there was nothing very likely to affract flies, or to make the towns unhealthy for billeting. Some time & recent rublish wer thrown about, and some troops are already billetted there, the sanitory arrangements being in most cases solliefactory, but some central somitary administration is required if troops are to occupy the area. The following suggestions are offered .-(a) The willages should be policed to ensure that troops billetted there leave I but their billets clean.
