

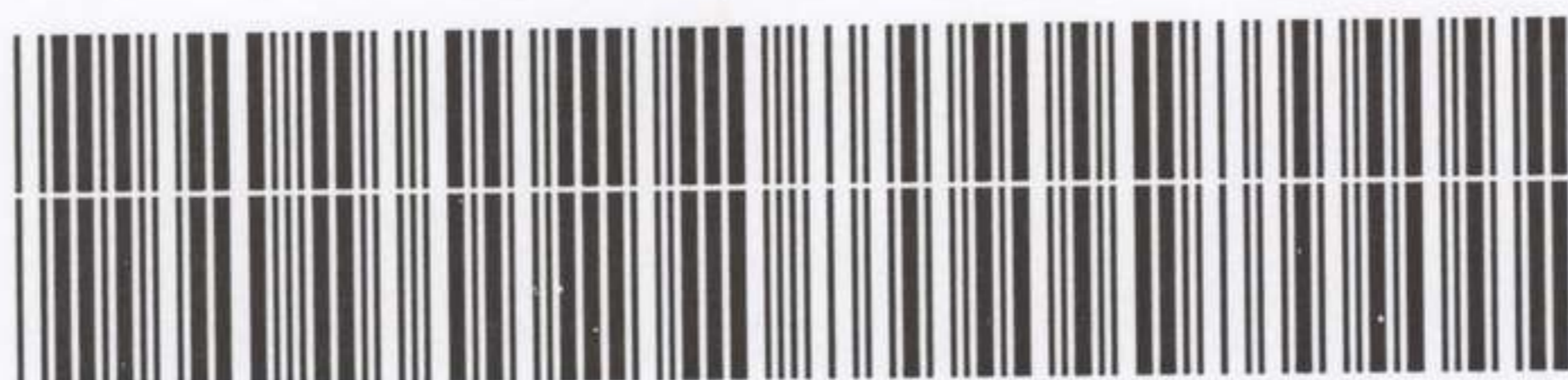

Maps 1 NAMUR. 1/100,000			<p>During this month the usual Daily Routines of Educational Lectures + Sports persisted.</p> <p>There was one evacuation from sickness.</p> <p>Two other ranks left for Industrial Employment in England.</p> <p>After the departure of N^o 14 Quota the strength of the Battalion was 4 Officers + 13 other ranks.</p> <p>There now remains only 3 officers + 3 other ranks over + above the cadres.</p> <p>This permitted of each man being assigned some regular duty in the working of the unit and gave them an added interest in its welfare.</p> <p>The General Health of all the troops remained good. discipline was excellent.</p>

14th March 1919.

1 The 4th A.I. Bde. will be amalgamated into one Battalion under command of Lt. Col. W. M. Davis. M. C. on the 14th inst. + will be known as the 4th A.I. Bde Battalion. 26th, 27th + 28th Battalions + 4th A.L.T.M.B. will be as companies of this Battalion.

The Battery will remain in its present location.

Correspondence to + from this unit will pass through 27th Bde + 26th Bde. H. Qs (latter now situated in old Bde. Head Quarters.)

2. Q. M. 26th Battalion will ration 4th A.I. Bde Battalion in this connection. Ration strength must read Bde. 4th A.I. Bde. Battalion. H. Qs. by 1800 hrs daily.
