LIESSIES.	1919 Feb 1 to Feb 28		<p>Throughout the month headquarters, 53rd Battery, 54th Battery and 55th Battery were billeted at LIESSIES and 114th Battery at RAMOUSIES.</p> <p><u>DEMOBILIZATION</u> No men were despatched, but 55th Battery and 114th Battery handed in all guns wagons and equipment and the a large number of horses were disposed of by auction sale.</p> <p><u>EDUCATIONAL</u> Educational classes were in full swing and lectures and debates also held at intervals.</p> <p><u>SPORTS</u> Football matches were continued altho hampered by the snow.</p> <p><u>HEALTH</u> The health of the Brigade throughout the month was excellent.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Stanley Berham</i> Lieut.
