		<p>In accordance with ANZAC Mounted Division order N^o 20 a reconnaissance of BIR EL ABD was carried out on July 1st 1916. Troops engaged in reconnaissance were 6th L.H. 4th L.H. Wellington M.R. Rgt. and also 1st L.H. Rgt. (1st A.L.H. Bde). Wellington M.R. Rgt. and 1 Squadron 6th L.H. Rgt. surrounded BIR EL ABD at daybreak on 1st July 1916.</p>
