

20.00		AUCKLAND MOUNTED RIFLES	REGIMENT.

ZIZA STATION	1/10/18	The Regiment stood to at 0400. At 0930 the 3rd Squadron moved West to MADEBA (143.Q.16) with orders to report on water and forage. During the morning all available men from the regiment assisted in loading captured enemy material on enemy train. At 1430 the Regiment less 3rd Squadron, and 11th Squadron (rearguard) moved with the Brigade back to AMMAN and bivouaced at 1900 in 142.Y.30.b. The 3rd Sqdn returned from MADEBA at 2130. Two Turk Officers and 30 other ranks P.of W. captured at MADEBA, also large quantities of grain. The 11th Squadron acted as rearguard to the Brigade and reached bivouac at 2000.	Ref Maps.  AMMAN. - 1. INTENTION 1. The Regiment with the N.Z.M.R. Brigade will move to TALAT ED DUMM, tomorrow 8th October 1918.

  2. On arrival at Nile 17, the Regiment will occupy old bivouac area.
- 2. MOVES.

  1. The Regiment will pass the starting point ROMAN ROAD 300 yds SOUTH of Regimental Headquarters, in column of route at 0830 tomorrow 8th Inst. Order of march as follows:-

- 2. All transport will be Brigaded for the march and will report to Brigade Transport Officer on Road NORTH of C.M.R. lines at 0830.
- 3. TRANSPORT. All Bivouac Sheets, Technical Equipment etc, will be stacked at SOUTH end of Squadron lines by 0700 tomorrow. Regimental 1st Line Transport is allotted as usual.
- 4. SICK HORSES. No horses with sore backs or girth galls are to be ridden. If sufficient sound horses are not available, to mount all ranks, those that cannot be mounted will proceed to JERUSALEM on Motor Lorries.
- 5. SANITATION. Special care must be given to sanitation, and the camp left in as clean a condition as possible. O.C. Sqdns will give this matter their personal attention, as complaints have lately been made about the insanitary state of camps vacated by the Regiment.

The Regiment with the N.Z.M.R. will leave JERUSALEM tomorrow 13th Oct, and march to LATRON. On 14th Oct. the Regiment will march to RICHON and will occupy old bivouac area.
