290. MONIES RECEIVED FOR CREDIT TO PAY ACCOUNTS.

With a view to the regularisation of procedure in this matter throughout the A.I.F. and to the prevention of fraud, the following instructions, which are issued for the guidance of all concerned, must in future be rigidly adhered to :-

1. No Pay Sergeant will accept any money from any member of the A.I.F. for credit in the latter's pay account, nor will any Pay Sergeant be authorised to sign an entry in a member's paybook in respect of any such credit or to sign a receipt therefor.
2. All monies which a member of the A.I.F. desires to pay in to the credit of his pay account must be tendered at the office of the Paymaster of the formation concerned, and all receipts for such monies and credit entries therefor in the Paybook will be signed only by the Paymaster or a duly authorised member of his Staff.
3. Every receipt for money received from any member of the A.I.F. for credit to his pay account, or for credit to any other account in the books of the Chief Paymaster, will be made out on the official receipt form supplied to Paymasters and no interim or other receipt other than such official receipt will be recognised in respect of any claim for reimbursement which may be made against the Chief Paymaster.
4. When making a credit entry in a paybook the authority for such credit i.e., the number of the official receipt, or the number of the "credit advice", will invariably be quoted. No payment on account of any such credit will be made unless supported by the official receipt or the credit advice as the case may be which must be produced together with the paybook at the time of payment. All books containing official receipt forms must at all times be kept under lock and key and the person shall be in possession of any such forms other than the Paymaster or a duly authorised member of his Staff.
5. It should be clearly understood than, in the event of any member of the A.I.F. entrusting money for credit to his pay account to any person other than those herein authorised, he will do so at his own risk. Such a transaction will be considered as being merely one between the parties concerned, and the Chief Paymaster will not accept any responsibility in the matter until the amount has been entered in the paybook and an official receipt issued as hereinbefore provided.
