

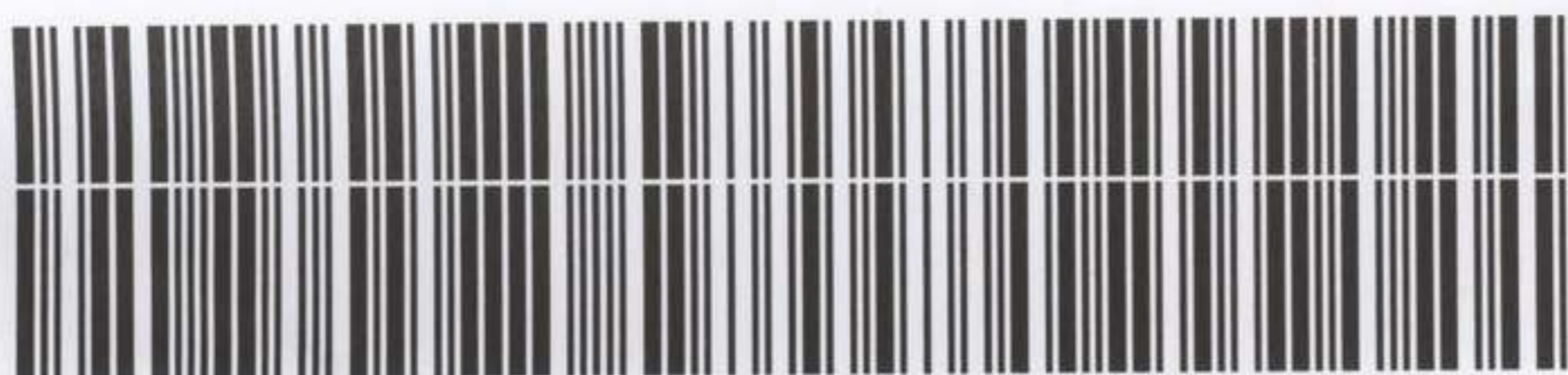

General Remarks.

A baby hatch is to be erected port side of No. 5 hatch to provide an extra means of egress to the women and children on Nos. 4 & 5 Main decks.

The existing boat accommodation is for 1000 per persons exclusive of the crew.

It is suggested that an extra boat be provided if this cannot be done, the total number of all ranks to be carried must be reduced to 1000.

There is only 1 bath for the 24 Officers proposed. It is suggested that the ladies bath be made available to officers, (say) 7 am.




