

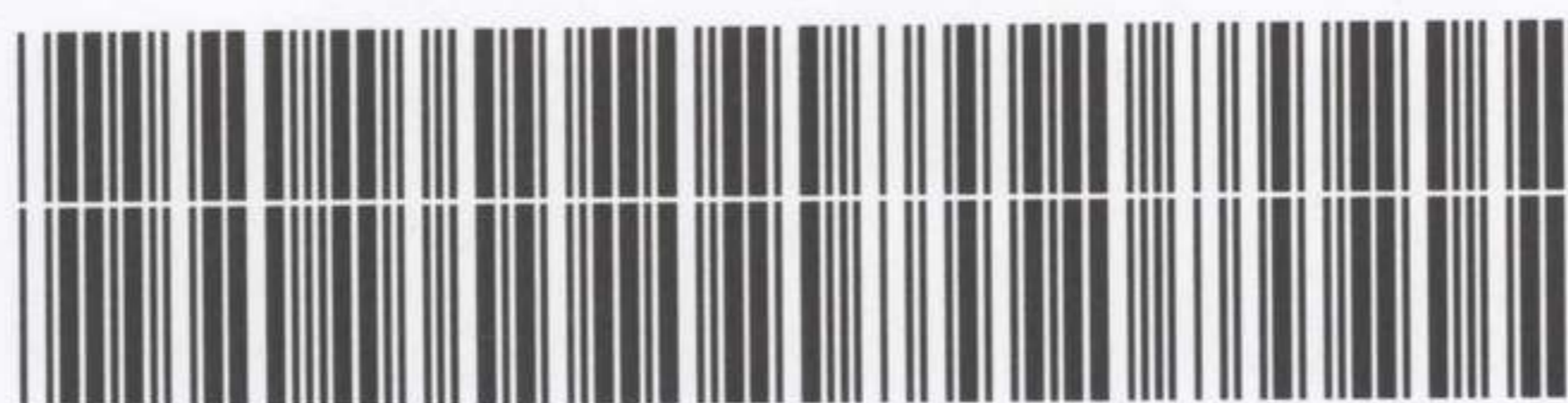

			<p><u>LOCATION.</u> Headquarters No. 5 Place Pirmez, CHATELET, BELGIUM. Workshops No. 332 Rue de Chatelet, COUILLET, BELGIUM.</p> <p>May was the quietest month on record as far as this Unit was concerned, as all the vehicles on charge and attached to the Unit were gradually handed over to the Australian Corps V.R.P. or transferred to other Units. All the personnel were disposed of by sending all the 1915-1916 personnel to Australia with quota 58, and transferring 1917 personnel to 3rd Aust M.T. Coy, and 1918 men and volunteers to 4th Aust M.T. Coy who are remaining in Belgium to carry out the transport for the various Membrials. The N.C.O's who signed certificates to remain for promotion have been transferred to 2nd Aust M.T. Company. These transfers of Personnel and vehicles necessitated a great deal of administrative work, but everything has been carried out successfully, and nothing now remains but for the "B" Cadre to square up, and take the Unit records to England (See app. I for Mileage etc)</p> <p>The shops have had a very busy time checking stores, tools and material, and spares of all kinds and handing them over to D.A.D.O.S., The V.R.P. to other units or sending them to the Base M.T. Depots. (See appendix 2 for work done in shops)</p> <p><u>STRENGTH</u> The Unit Cadre of 1 Officer and 5 Other Ranks is the only personnel left to wind up the work of the 1st Aust M.T. Company, which I think will bear comparison with the work of any M.T. Unit in the B.E.F.</p>
