WAR DIARY OF D.A.P.M. - MONTH OF NOVEMBER 1918.

LOCATION OF OFFICE.BELLOY - sur - SOMME  
CARTIGNIES.7/10/18 to 24/11/18.  
26/11/18. -

A "Round - up" was organised at Corbie and Amiens resulting in the arrest of 4 long standing absentees in each place.

In connection with the march to Germany the men of my command left Belloy - sur Somme on 24/11/18 and entrained at Hangast reaching Bertry at 5-30 pm. on 25/11/18. From Bertry the journey was resumed by road to Bohain, where a halt was made for the night. The journey was resumed on 26/11/18 and Cartignies reached that night, and the Office opened.

4 M.M.P. were attached for duty to each Brigade during the march.

The conduct of the troops was excellent.
