July 3 rd	2 nd Lieut AAM Sandison joined 7 th 13th ^{13th} Battery RFA	Vol 1
" 4 th	Lieut E.J. Walton RFA (SR) posted to LDAC from orderly officer to OC 131 st B ^{de} RFA.	
" 11 th	Received orders to be ready to move south and to fill up sections with ammunition from 6 th DAC relieving us.	
" 14 th	The Column left POPERINGHE and proceeded by rail route in seven trains. Part of the column entrained at GODSWAERYELDTE, part at BAILLEUL MAIN and BAILLEUL WEST. Those entraining at the first named place detrained at DOULLENS and those entraining at the two last named places detrained at CANDAS. On arrival at railhead, the Headquarters with Nos 1, 2, 3 Sections marched to MONTRELET and No 4 Section to ST LEGER LES DOMARTS where they were respectively billeted. The Lahore DAC now belongs to the 4 th Australian Division Reserve of the 1 st Australian and New Zealand Corps in the 1st Army.
