HAVRE	2/4/16		Entrained at night for BERGUETTE.	
BERGUETTE	3/4/16		Arrived at BERGUETTE on night of 3/4/16 and went into billets at BLARINGHAM. Two officers & thirty (30) gunners per battery were sent to the front for instructional purposes.	
BLARINGHAM	5/4/16		The C.O., adjutant, orderly officer and 12 other ranks of the H.Q. staff moved to ARMENTIARES & commenced to "take over" from the 176 th brigade R.F.A.	
ARMENTIARES	10/4/16		The remainder of the brigade moved up from BLARINGHAM & were billeted at STEENWERCKE. Lt. Col. LLOYD was transferred to the 5 th F.A. brigade.	
do	12/4/16		St. Col. DAVIDSON took command of the brigade.	
do	{ 21/4/16 22/4/16 22/4/16 23/4/16		"C" and "D" batteries of 176 th Bde R.F.A. were relieved by our 104 th & 105 th batteries respectively. The relief was carried out at night by sections. At the same time our wagon lines moved up to the billets previously occupied by those of the 176 th Bde. R.F.A. The 106 th battery remained in its billet and began the preparing the new
