

(1) You will detail two Coys. under command of your second in command to proceed to ISMAILIA FERRY STATION to occupy the trenches there.

Maj. Mc. Nicoll will report to Col. Ellesmere 56th. P. Rifles.

Twenty-four hours rations and forage to be carried in haversacks.

Your cook's cart will accompany the Two Coys. with proportion of Camp Equipment.

Proportion of first line Transport will also accommany the detachment.

One blanket and ground sheet per Officer and man. The detachment is not to reach the FERRY station before 10 a.m. as the road will not be clear earlier.

2. The remainder of your Bn. is the Unit "in readiness".

See "normal method of move", but you will have only one water cart,

maltese cart, one waggon limbered G.S. for signalling etc., one waggon

limbered for M.G. and belts and two S.A.A. carts..

Otherwise the "normal method of move" applies in its entirety.

You require to be able to move within one hour of notice to move.

Men however go to bed as usual, but everything must be ready for instant action.

ISMATLIA. 7/2/15.

- 1. "C" & "D" Coys., Sth. BN. and 2 platoons "A" Coy, 7th. BN. will move from ISMAILIA BIVOUAC on Sth. February 1915, at hour to be notified later. They will carry 150 rounds S.A.A. per man on the soldier with 100 paunds per man in boxes. Twenty-four hours cooked rations to be carried in haversacks. Three day's preserved meat and biscuit ration in haversack, or otherwise as practicable, or further notified.
- 2. "C" Coy, 8th. Bn. will be able to use Bn. transport for all purposes. "D" Coy, 8th. BN. will on arrival at destination, be paraded with 12 mules to carry S.A.A. and 30 mules to carry blankets. Troops will carry W.P. sheets and at least 1 blanket per man. Cooking equipment to be taken. Three day's reserve of fuel to be taken.
- 3. It is intended to supply uncooked rations daily to avoid breaking in on reserve rations.
- 4. 2 "C" Coy. 8th.BN. will probably move by road. "D" Coy. 8th.BN
 by train. 2 Platoons "A" Coy, by road and launch.
- 2nd. in command, 8th. BN. will proceed with "D" Coy. 8th. BN. and Assistant Adjt. may be permitted to accompany him. O.C. Coy. and C.S.Major, or C.Q.M.S. at the option of the Coy. commander, with the 2 Platoons "A" Coy., 7th. BN..
- 6. No 1st. line transport drivers and no horses will accompany troops.

1. With reference to Operation Order No. 3 the Detachments of New Zealand Infantry now at <u>FL FERDAN</u>, <u>HOSPITAL BATTERY</u>, <u>FERRY POST</u> and <u>SERAPEUM</u> will be relieved by detachments from the <u>2nd</u>. Australian BRIGADE as follows:-

EL FERDAN, EAST Bank EL FERDAN WEST Bank HOSPITAL BATTERY, WEST Bank FERRY POST, EAST Bank SERAPEUM

- 2. The detachments will be relieved weekly.
- 3. The detachment at SPRAPRUM will be under the orders of G.O.C., SPRAPRUM sub-section, Canal Defence.
- 4. The detachments at PERRY POST, HOSPITAL BATTERY, and EL FERDAY, East Bank will be under the orders of G.O.C., 28th. (FF) Bde..
- 5. The detachment at ML FERDAN will be under the orders of G.O.C., 32nd. (I.S.) Bde..
- 6. Detachments will be relieved weekly by Australian and New Zealand troops alternately.
- 7. Movements to and from the <u>FERRY POST</u> and <u>HOSPITAL BATTERY</u> will be by road; the relieving detachments to reach these places by 11.30 a.m.

Any reserve rations with the New Zealand Detachments will be handed to relieving detachments, 0's C. of which will check and give a receipt for supplies handed over.

ISMATLTA. 9/2/15.

1. Bde. H.Q., 7th. Bn., 8th. Pn. and Bde. Section Divl. May Sig. Coy. and Supply Details A.S.C.. will return to Mena Camp, Cairo by train leaving ISMAILIA Station goods platform as follows:
Thursday 11th. Feb. 7.30 a.m. B.H.Q. & 28th. Bn..

8.30 a.m. Half 8th. Bn.

Friday 12th. February 7.30 a.m.. Bde. Sec. Divl. Sig. Coy. & 27th. Bn. 8.30 a.m. Half 7th. Bn. & Supply Details A.S.C..

- 2. Bn. Omdrs. will divide the H.Q. and other details of their commands in such a way as to suit the train accommodation.
- 3. Trains will be ready for loading each day at 6 a.m. and 7.45 a.m. respectively.
- 4. Trains are timed to reach Cairo each day at 12.15 p.m. and 2 p.m. respectively. Bn. Omdrs. will make the necessary arrangements re rations & forage.
- 5. On arrival at Cairo each train load will proceed to Exice Mena by route march not waiting for any other trains to arrive.
- 6. The transport Details A.S.C. now with the Bde. will remain at ISMAILIA whilst the Yeomanry Brigade remains there but it will return with the Brigade the rations brought with the Brigade including the 7 days reserve rations.
- 7. Of the 382 boxes of S.A.A. from Zagezig in possession of the Brigade 280 will be loaded into trucks at a place and hour to be detailed later by a fatigue 50 men 7th. Battalion which will also provide any transport necessary. The remaining 102 boxes will be delivered to the O.C. New Zealand Infantry Brigade and a receipt taken for them.

8. The detachment now in posts along the canal will be withdrawn tomorrow as follows:-

At PL FERDAN - by train leaving about 11 a.m., at the FERRY POST (E Bank) by ferry and route m arch leaving at 11 a.m., O.C. 8th. Bn. to have necessary transport at the Ferry. At the HOSPITAL BARTERY on Being relieved by 1 platoon New Zealand Infantry at 11 a.m.. O.C. 8th. Bn. to have necessary transport at the Batteryyat that hour. At SEREPEUM by hunch leaving at 3.30 p.m.. O.C. 7th. Bn. to provide necessary transport from the CUSTO M HOUSE JETTY. Except in the case of the HOSPITAL BATTERY the platoons will not be replaced.

9. Advance parties of 1 Officer and 3 men will be sent to Mena by the m 10 a.m. train from ISMATLIA. tomorrow morning.

10. 0's C. Bns. will be responsible for guarding rations or stores on either or both their trains and will supply any fatigues necessary to assist in moving, loading or unloading them.

11. The Bde. Major and Vet. Officer will remain at ISMATLIA till the second troop train on Friday 12th. inst.

12. Haversack rations at discretion of C.O.

13. Fatigue parties will be detailed by the 7th. and 8th. Bns. as directed later to assist in loading and unloading supplies.
