

Froid-chapelle Belgium	March 1st to March 31st		<p>Headquarters 53rd Bty, 54th Bty, and 55th Bty, were billeted at Liessies, and the 114th Bty, at Ramousies, till March 12th.</p> <p>On March 12th Headquarters and the 4 above Batteries removed to Froid-chapelle, Belgium, where they are now billeted. The 53rd Bty amalgamated with the 114th Bty. and the 54th Bty with the 55th Bty.</p> <p>Demobilisation. On March 24th, 4 officers and 167 other ranks were despatched for ordinary repatriation. The remainder of the horses and mules were disposed of by auction.</p> <p>Educational Educational classes were held and a number of men placed for the study of Technical courses.</p> <p>Health.
