

FRANVILLER (SOMME)		/18.	During the Month I have inspected all Units under my Administration. Condition of animals has been well maintained. Forage has been good in quality. A reduction of 11b.hay was made during the month.	
			Watering conditions have been good. DISEASE At chose of month disease is practically non-existent. Mange has cleared up and Ophthalmia is on the decline. On arrival in new Area IOth Infantry Brigade lost 15 animals from Shell Fire. MOB.VET.SECTION. M.V.S. during the month admitted 58 animals,44 of these were Evacuated and 14 Returned to Units.	
		Entraining was carried out from 3 Centres:- 9th Brigade Gropp STEENBECQUE 10th " ST.OMER 11th " " ARQUES. A Veterinary Officer was detailed to supervise entraining (8 Trains) in each Group, whilst Brigade Veterinary Sergeant supervised detraining at MONDICOURT PAS and DOULLENS. Veterinary Officer of 10th Infantry Brigade Group had reason to complain of dirty Trucks causing Horses to fall whilst in transit; otherwise move was very satisfactorily carried out. Artillery Brigades Groups travelled by Road from MORBECQUE to FRANVILLERS. Water for animals was the only difficulty which presented itself, the only supplies in some places being dirty
