

Events and Information

INTELLIGENCE SUMMAR (Erase heading not required.)

During the month I inspected all Units under my administration.

On the night of 31st a bomb fell in horse lines of 30th Bettery, directly in amongst the horses Two Rides and sixteen L.Ds were killed outright. Veterinary Officer destrayed One Ride, and twelve L.Ds, and thirteen were evacuated to M.V.S. I inspected lines after occurrence and am of the opinion that no blame rests with Unit.
