

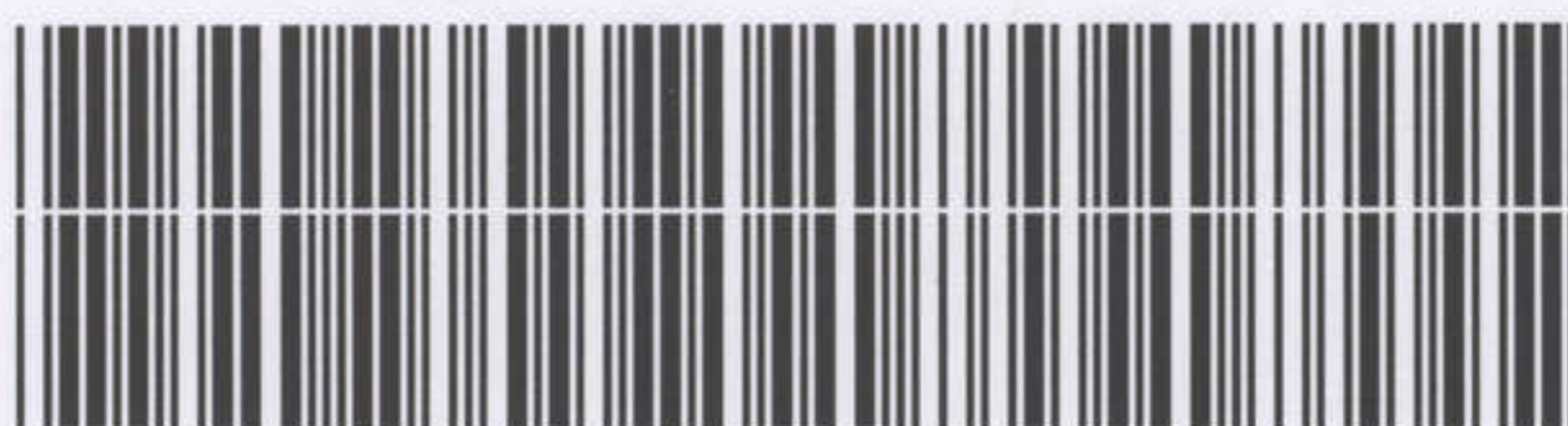

22-3-16	<p> Dental Lt. Henderson and his unit reported. Instructed him to report to A.D.M.S. Tel-el-Kebir. It is arranged that Major Butler may D.A.D.M.S. in L- accompanying Col. Mansfield. D.D.M.S. was received from 3rd Field Amb. thus the unit was complete. The med. personnel of 1st Amb. Division is now complete including dental units for the ambulances and A.C.C.S., the unit of the latter comprises 2 Staff Sgts. for mechanical work. Word from O.C. 1 A.C.C.S. stating that the exchange with the 11 C.C.S. had been carried out satisfactorily. Instructed O.C. 2 A.C.C.S. to supply batman for chaplain and to apply for reinforcements to complete establishment. Four men over establishment - 1 A.C.C.S. sent to report for duty to A.D.M.S. Tel-el-Kebir. Send instructions to A.D.M.S. N.S. Division regarding - short arm inspection, inoculation and disinfection before evacuation. Word from M.F. Division requesting 2000 tubes of calf lymph (should have stated doses a no. of men to be vaccinated). </p>

23-3-16	<p>21. Col. Heam of 2nd Field Amb. ^{wrote} called for instructions. The Field Ambulance being closed, should patients be sent to J.H.F. Ambulance or direct to 11th CCS and both of practicable send all to J.H.F. Amb, otherwise to 11th CCS.</p>	
24-3-16	<p>21. Pige wrote saying he was expecting to join the 3rd 2 H. Rgt at Road Head, Serapium F.</p>	
25-3-16	<p>Capt. Irving 8 FJ Amb reported. Was an advance party of 13 other ranks for Ferry Post. arranged with R.T.O to give instruction that teams at Mahramma and Moussem pick up any casualties from the 4th & 5th Divisions on the march from Teletkehi.</p>	
26-3-16	<p>D.A.D.M.S 6th Division reported - To make all necessary sanitary arrangements at Ferry Post.</p>	
27-3-16	<p>A.D.M.S 5th Division called - visited Hospital team which brought in 17 men who fell out on line of march. These cases were admitted into No 1 A.S. Hospital.</p>

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28-2-16	<p>A. D. M. S. 6th Div. called instructed him to his duties - principally not to vacate evacuate any but serious cases, all dental cases to be retained and those likely to remain within 14 days, also to put up ply-proof latrines and do away with native latrine.</p> <p>M. Col. Merkle C.O. 4th Field Ambulance called and was instructed in regard to casualties on line of march.</p>	
29-2-16	<p>Visited Tel-el-Keha instructed O.C. No 2 Stationary Hospital not to evacuate dental or minor cases, and to retain all cases likely to remain within 14 days. Visited 14th Amb. Field Ambulance and saw the O.C. M. & Sanitation Section. Major Black, Capt. Bean and Maplestone reported for duty, instructed to report for duty with 8th Field Amb. W. O. Baker reported, instructed to report for duty as Sup W. O. with the 4th Field Amb.</p> <p>M. Col. H. K. Bean reported to take command of the 3 L. H. F. Amb. at Serapeum. M. Col. G. T. White to be O.C. 2. A. S. H. Captain V. O. Slaney to be attached also to G. M. Reaney's unit in reconnaissance</p>

30-3-16	<p>Captain Lind reported for duty instructed to report to 5th Division Capt. Farrar M.O. 54 Bin called saying he is suffering from enteric fever and wishes to exchange with a hospital unit where he can get treatment. Arranged with M. I. A. H. and A. D. M. S. 4th Division for transfer of march casualties from No. 1 and 2 Stat. Hospital to F. Amb. of 5th Division.</p>	
31-3-16	<p>A. D. M. S. 4th Division called instructed him as to his duties. Major Thompson visited Mouscar bivouac camp and found everything satisfactory with regard to sanitation. Am collecting all data and reports of the march from Tel-el-Reh to Mouscar.</p>
