	2.19.		15th. Battery played 13th. Battery (Australian Rules) Football, resulting in a win for the 15th. Battery. This places the 15th. Battery in the Finals. The final match of the Competition will be played against the 2nd. Section, 2nd. D.A.C. at an early date. Heavy snow fell all the morning.	
	2.19.		Sleet & snow continue to fall and snow is still lying on the ground. The men of Brigade Headquarters had a Demobilisation Dinner to which they invited all the Officers of Brigade Headquarters. It proved a very pleasant and successful evening. Captain G.L. DEAN and 11 other ranks departed by train en route for AUSTRALIA. Included in this number were a few of the original members of the Brigade.	
	2.19.		The Sergeants of the Divisional Artillery gave a Dance in the Hotel-de-Ville, THUIN. It was a very well managed and successful turn out.	
	2.19.		Lieut.-Colonel H.W. RIGGALL DSO. who has been relieving Brig. General O.F. PHILLIPS, DSO. & C.R.A. (2nd. Div. Artillery) for the past two and half months resumed command of the Brigade.	
	2.19.		Major R.M. THOMPSON, DSO. MC. received instructions to report to A.I.F., H.Q. - Demobilisation Department for Repatriation. 11 a.m. C.O. and Adjutant visited the 14th. Battery.	
	2.19.		A very heavy fall of snow during the night (5th/6th) the heaviest we have yet experienced. During the morning all the civilians stood in the streets well armed with snow balls and every passer-by had a very severe gauntlet to run. Almost every second soldier was taking photos, and in all parts of the Town parties assembled and fights were arranged, the whole Town presented a beautiful view.	
	2.19.		A very severe frost was experienced. Nine teams and 4 H.C.O.'s under Lieut. C.G. ROBERTS proceeded to JEUMONT for Guns and Ammunition Wagons of the 6th. (Army) A.F.A. Brigade. These Guns and Wagons were brought to THUIN and parked for the night in the vicinity of the 4th. A.F.A. Brigade Headquarters. The teams from the Batteries were a little late in turning up (as "frost clogs" had to be screwed into the shoes before leaving. The party returned to THUIN at 6.30 p.m. It was very cold outside billets.	
	2.19.		At 8.45 a.m. nine teams from the Brigade "hooked in" to the Guns and Wagons of the 6th. (Army) Brigade and took them to the Station at CHATINEAULEAU where they were handed over to an Officer of the 6th. (Army) Brigade. Teams returned to Thuin by 6 p.m. The 15th. Battery Officers gave a Dinner to their Football Teams at the Cafe Lion Belge.	
	2.19.		Captain C.C. MORTON MC. has been sent to the 4th. A.F.A. Brigade to command the 10th. Battery for three weeks.	
	2.19.		Lieut. I.F. MACHERSON MC. proceeded to CHATINEAULEAU to witness the entraining of all vehicles and stores of the 6th. (Army) Brigade A.F.A. with a view to obtaining any hints which would assist this Brigade when our turn comes for despatch of Guns, Wagons, etc. and stores to Base. The final match of the Rugby Football Competition was played in about 6 inches of snow between the 13th. and 15th. Batteries which resulted in a win by 6 points to 3 points in favour of the 13th. Battery. The 15th. Battery played a very fine and forcing game and had it been a fine day the 15th. Battery would most probably have been the premier team.	
	2.19.		The day was very cold and the snow was still lying frozen on the ground. At 9 a.m. the thermometer registered 15 degrees below zero.	
	2.19.		The morning proved a very cold one, and the canal Du-SAMBRE was almost completely frozen. Orders were received for a further 70 horses to be sent to LE HAVRE tomorrow. The Veterinary Officer Malleined all the 'X' Class Horses and Mules of Brigade H.Q., 15th. Battery and 105th. Battery this morning, and examined all the 'Y' Class Horses in the Brigade this afternoon.

2.19. A batch of 70 'Y' Class Horses were despatched to Base (LE HAVRE). The party under Lieut. R.S.T. MATTHEWS MC. and 2/Lieut. R.W.G. MOXON assembled at the square THUIN at 6.30 a.m. and moved off at 7 a.m. for CHARLEROI. Horses were entrained at CHARLEROI. The total number of horses now with the Brigade is 294. Sales are being arranged and it is expected that practically all horses of the Brigade will be sold on the 27th. and 28th. February and 1st. of March. 2 p.m. C.O. and Adjutant went to a Conference at 2nd. D.A.H.Q. with regard to the Demobilising of the Brigade. 7.30 p.m. Battery Commanders reported at Brigade Headquarters and it was arranged that the following other ranks who sailed in 1915 could be spared. 1 R.S.M. 29 N.C.O's and 137 other ranks.

The snow is still lying on the ground but strong sun shone all day and the thaw has at last commenced.

2.19. Instructions received that a Draft of 5 officers and 175 other ranks who embarked from Australia 1915 comprise Brigade's share of Embarkation Quota No. 17.

2.19. Lists of 1915 men have been received from Batteries. Thaw has set in, but still a lot of snow lies on the ground.

2.19. The Right Section of 15th. Battery had its Demobilisation Dinner at the Cafe Lion Belge THUIN at 6.30 p.m. The 13th. Battery gave their Football Team a Dinner at LOBBES. 2nd. D.A.H.Q. advise that the 13th. 14th. and 15th. Batteries will be disbanded and all stores, Guns, Wagons, etc. will be sent to Base on the 19th. in a special train. All stores, harness etc. are to be packed and labelled.

2.19. Centre Section, 15th. Battery had their Demobilisation Dinner at the Cafe Lion Belge, THUIN.

2.19. Left Section of 15th. Battery had their Demobilisation Dinner at Cafe Lion Belge, THUIN at 6.30 p.m.

The 2nd. Divisional Artillery Race Club had a meeting. The first Race commenced at 12 o'clock mid-day. It was quite a successful Meeting but with a small attendance in comparison to the previous Meeting. The Course and Ground were very Muddy. A number of outsiders won the races. Brigade H.Q. Officers gave a send off Dinner to Lieut.-Colonel H.W. RIGGALL DSO. and Lieut. S.L. ROBERTS MC.

7.2.19. A large Draft of 1915 personnel were despatched from the 2nd. Div. Artillery by a special train leaving THUIN NORD at 1.35 p.m. The 5th. F.A. Brigade share was 5 Officers (Lieut.-Colonel H.W. RIGGALL DSO., Lieut. S.L. ROBERTS MC. Major J.E. MITCHELL. 2/Lieut. R.G. ANDERSON, and 2/Lieut. G.B. HARGREAVES) and 127 170 N.C.O's and men. The men comprised practically all of the "Old Originals" from the Brigade who sailed in November 1915, there are now left 13 Sergeants and 33 other ranks who sailed from Australia in 1915. The Brigade party assembled in the Rue Yesterstevens, THUIN-Ville-Basse and marched to the THUIN-NORD Station Yard. At 12.45 p.m. a great number of the Civil population of the Town gathered amongst the men to say "Good-bye" and there were numerous affectionate and heartbreaking farewells. A number of the BELGIQUE then kissed our men on both cheeks and wished them "Bon voyage". The special train arrived at 1.25 p.m. Not a single man was reported absent or even late. Everyone of them - although a few may have felt the parting for a few moments - showed a great keenness and longing and great satisfaction that it was at last their turn to return to their Homes. The train took them to the Reinforcement Camp at MARCHIENNE-ZONE and they expected to leave by train for LE HAVRE on 18th. instant.

	8.2.19.		Officers of 2nd. Div. Artillery gave a Dance in the Hotel-de-Ville, THUIN and it passed off very successfully.	
	9.2.19.		An evening was given to the Soldiers of the 2nd Div. Artillery, a number of 5th. Brigade attended, by the Towns people of THUIN. Old English Games were indulged in, the evening was quite successful.	
	10.2.19.		Education Classes are continuing. The attendance is small but is good in proportion of strength. The weather has been mild. No rain.	
	11.2.19.		Instructions received that the Right Honorable W.M. HUGHES, Prime Minister for Australia would arrive in THUIN and deliver a lecture on 22nd. instant.	
	12.2.19.		3.45 p.m. The Right Honorable Wm. HUGHES addressed the 2nd. Divisional Artillery in Hotel-de-Ville, THUIN and was very enthusiastically received. His lecture subject was "Demobilisation and Repatriation" and "What was being done at the Peace Conference".	
	13.2.19.		One French Chasseur Regiment marched into THUIN to billet for the night on their way to AIX-LA-CHAPELLE. Five of their Officers were entertained in the evening by Brigade Headquarters. Lieut. N.T. KINGSMILL and J.W. FERGUSON returned from BRUSSELS leave.	
	14.2.19.		Lieut. P.L. OFFICER departed on U.K. leave. Weather very mild. As one Chasseur Regiment departed by Train another Regiment marched into the Town. All 'Z' Class horses have been sent to the 11th. Battery Lines under an Officer and a party of men. These horses will be looked after there until they are sold by Public Auction on the 27th and 28th. instant.	
	15.2.19.		Weather very mild. All preparations made for 13th. Battery to take all Guns, Wagons, Vehicles and stores to D.A.D.O.S, CHARLEROI tomorrow. The Veterinary Officer inspected all the Brigades 'Z' class horses which are picketed at the 11th. Battery Lines and scissor marked with the Letter T and in numerical order.	
	16.2.19.		The 13th. Battery took all their Guns, Ammunition Wagons, Mess Carts, Water Carts and Stores and Equipment into D.A.D.O.S. at MARCINELLE and CHARLEROI. The Battery had not kept all the stores of each section (Of Mobilisation Store Table) in separate boxes as they had been instructed, this meant that the stores had to be unpacked and repacked at D.A.D.O.S. An Officer from each of the 14th. 15th. and 105th. Batteries visited D.A.D.O.S. with the 13th. Battery and they will be able to make any necessary alterations prior to leaving THUIN. The 13th. Battery could not have everything checked and receipted today. One officer and a few other ranks will go tomorrow to complete everything. This is really the beginning of the end of this fine old Brigade, and each Battery Commander will feel greatly relieved of his responsibilities as his Battery is handed in.	
	17.2.19.		Lieut. R.S.T. MATTHEWS M.C. departed by the 8 a.m. train for the Reinforcement Camp, MARCHIENNE-AU-PONT en route to Australia. His application for early Repatriation was approved. At 7.30 a.m. the 14th. Battery took all guns, wagons, stores etc. to D.A.D.O.S. today for return to Base. As all harness had to be stripped and packed it is necessary for the 4th. F.A. Brigade to supply animals and harness and drivers to move each Battery. The Ammunition of the 13th. and 14th. Batteries is at present dumped and is under cover awaiting to be transported to the Corps Dump. At 8.30 a.m. 16 G.S. Wagons and Teams reported to the 15th. and 105th. Batteries on to which all the Ammunition of these two batteries was packed and taken to Corps Dump, at FORGES-DE-RECQUIGNIES. (NAMUR 3 A 1/100,000.). An Officer and a Sergeant took charge of the party.

Battery complete handed Howitzers, Ammunition Wagons, Stores etc. in, and all but the Machine Guns were checked and receipted. The Machine Guns will be completed tomorrow. The sale of Horses is proceeding in the Square THUIN. The strength of the Brigade is :-

1. In continuation of 2nd Aust.Div.Arty. 20/109 13/2/19. Nominal Roll of personnel selected for above quota herewith.
 2. Units will at once advise if any man mentioned on Roll is not able to proceed with Draft.
 3. Personnel will proceed to 2nd Aust.Div.Reinforcement Wing MARCHIENNE-AU-PONT by special train on 17th February 1919.
 4. 2nd Aust.D.A.H.Q., 4th and 5th Brigades and 2nd Aust.D.A.C. will each parade their respective party at a suitable place (not at the Railway Station) and check rolls and march their party to THUIN NOED Railway Station.
Parties will form up in Railway Station Yards at 1845 17th February 1919 and will not proceed on to Railway Platform until ordered to do so.
 5. Reports will be made to Staff Captain, 2nd Aust.Div.Arty. at 1300 at THUIN Railway Station.
 6. Lieut-Colonel H.W.RIGGALL. DSO. will be in charge of Draft.
 7. The Special train consists of 19 trucks and 1 carriage for officers - 35 men will travel in each truck - The 13th Light Horse will use portion of train - They will entrain at FONTAINE VALMONT.
The 13th Battery personnel may entrain at LOBBES and the personnel from the S.A.A.Section, 2nd Aust.D.A.C. may report direct to 2nd Aust.Div.Reinforcement Wing between 1500 and 1600 17th February 1919. These men will report direct to Lieut-Col. H.W.RIGGALL DSO.
 8. Detraining Station is MARCHIENNE ZONE.
 9. RATIONS. - All Ranks will assemble carrying the unconsumed portion of the current day's rations, plus iron rations.
 10. DISCIPLINE. - The O.C. Quota will be O.C. Train and will submit a report of the journey to 2nd Aust.D.H.Q. from Aust.Base Depot. A picked Guard of 10% will be told off from each quota. This Guard will be employed keeping discipline throughout the journey. On the train they will be posted at each end and in the centre of the train in which the draft is travelling. The draft conducting N.C.O's. will travel one in each truck or carriage occupied by the draft. The drafts will be warned before they leave their Units that certain orders will be strictly observed throughout the journey :-
 - (a) Men are only to travel in the trucks or compartments allotted them - on no account are men to travel on roofs or buffers.
 - (b) Men are not to leave the trucks in which they are travelling without permission and at a halt will not go out of the station yard without permission.
 - (c) No wine, beer or other intoxicant are to be taken into the trucks in which men are travelling.Men will be warned that any men guilty of disobedience of these orders will be sent back to their units for trial by F.G.C.M. and will forfeit their right to early return to Australia.


