1 MOUNTAIN BTY R A A - N G FORCE.

With reference to L.H.Q. S.M.12522 dated 6 July 42 it has been decided that the guns and minimum personnel necessary are to be despatched as soon as possible, to be followed by the remaining personnel and the horses, later.

It is, therefore, desired that the unit be considered as consisting of three parties.

- (a) "A" party, the minimum necessary to serve the guns, without transport.
- (b) "B" party, the transport component.
- (c) "C" party, the remainder.

2. "A" party will proceed first and "B" party when the transport is organized. The despatch of "C" party will be carried out later as transport becomes available. The composition of "A", "B" and "C" parties is as shown on the attached Appendix "A".

3. Action will be taken to concentrate the unit in N.S.W. at an early date for organization under H.Q. N.S.W. L. of C. Area, prior to movement to N.G.

4. It is desirable that the battery commander should make personal selection of as many of the unit as possible, and, therefore, arrangements for complete concentration should be made forthwith regardless of the priority of despatch.

5. H.Q., N.S.W. L. of C. Area will supply replacements for the personnel withdrawn from First Aust Army.

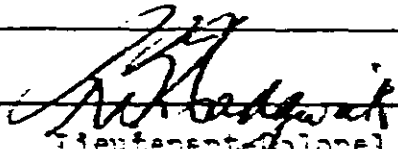

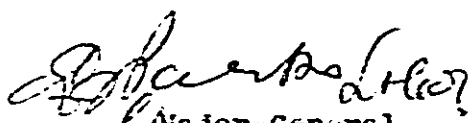

MEDICAL EXAMINATION - SEASONAL WORKERS.

To provide labour for rural and seasonal works the Director-General of Man Power has made provision for the establishment of a Register of Seasonal Workers compiled from men not at present serving with the Armed Forces. Many of these men are in Defence Act Classes not as yet called up for medical examination, whilst others may have been medically examined previously and classed either permanently or temporarily medically unfit.

It has been decided that whilst men are engaged on any seasonal occupation as directed by the Director-General of Man Power or his Deputies in the various States they are not to be called up for medical examination or re-examination, and Area Officers are to be instructed to consult their relevant National Service Officers so as to arrange deletion from call up for medical examination of men actually engaged on seasonal occupations.

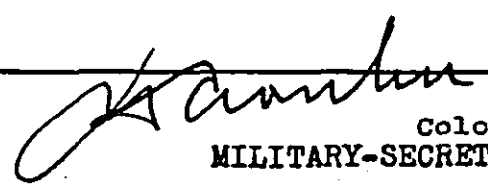

ARTILLERY SURVEY UNITS - RE-ORGANIZATION.

1. It can be anticipated that an amendment to the O of E will be made deleting Survey Regts, R A A , and substituting one Flash Spotting Bty in each Corps Artillery, and one Survey Bty in each Divisional Artillery.
2. It is not intended to employ artillery survey personnel in M T F., and, therefore, the survey battery for M T F will be allotted for the present to Second Army.
3. A Survey Staff Officer (Lieut-Col) has been provided on each H.Q. Corps Arty and for B R A, Second Aust Army. This officer will be responsible for the control of the F S Bty, and he will maintain contact with the Survey Bty of the Div Arty in technical matters. If the Arty units of two or more Divs are deployed together, he will ensure that survey liaison is maintained between neighbouring formations.
4. A nucleus of 2 officers and 20 other ranks Sound Ranging personnel is to be allotted to S of A (Fd) Holsworthy, for maintenance of equipment to be concentrated there, and for maintaining sound ranging technique as an insurance against future requirements.
5. The outline of the re-organization is as per attached appendix "A", and will be covered by amendments to be made to the O of E. W Es for the units concerned will be issued at an early date.
6. The re-organization will result in certain personnel becoming surplus to requirements; and it is desirable that those who possess superior educational and technical qualifications should be absorbed in units where these qualifications will be of greatest use. Suggested avenues of employment are as follows:-
 - Survey Coys, R.A.E. - Qualified surveyors, draftsmen, topographers.
 - Survey parties of Fd & Med Regts - Arty Surveyors.
 - R A A., Ey & A A - Radio location training for those possessing high educational qualifications particularly in physics.

7. Nominal Rolls of all officers at present on the regimental lists of the three regiments are to be submitted and are to show:-

- (a) present posting.
- (b) posting under new organization.

In this connection, a seconded officer should be posted to a Bty under the new organization and remain seconded.

8. It is desired that the Commanding Officers of the present three Survey Regts should arrange, in consultation with the nominated Commanders of the new Batteries being formed from their respective Regts, for selection of personnel to fill the new units, and that they should then forward to L H Q nominal rolls of surplus personnel showing qualifications and recommend employment, with trade group classifications, if any.

9. Instructions regarding equipment, movement of new units, disposal of surplus personnel, and training of reinforcements will be issued later.

10. Action will be taken by the formations concerned to implement the foregoing instructions.
