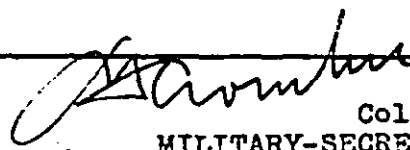

MR. BUDGE

With reference to Military Board memorandum No. 79394 dated 28th November 1940, and subsequent amendments thereto, relative to the issue of War Badges, it is advised that the following revised conditions have been approved and will operate forthwith:-

2. "RETURNED FROM ACTIVE SERVICE BADGE"

The eligibility for the Returned from Active Service Badge, vide para 2a. of M.B.M. 79394 has now been extended to the following classes of personnel:-

- (i) Army personnel who were stationed on full time duty in a prescribed operational area in Australia or the Territories as set out hereunder.
- (ii) That, for the present, the prescribed operational areas for the purpose of (i) and the commencing dates for qualifying service in those areas are as follows:-

Northern Territory North of	) 19th February 1942.
Parallel 14.50 South	
Mandated New Guinea	4th January 1942.
Papua	2nd February 1942.
Torres Strait Islands	15 March 1942.

3. FEMALE RELATIVES BADGE:

The extension of the issue of the Returned from Active Service Badge will similarly affect the issue of the Female Relatives Badge.

4. MOTHERS AND WIDOWS BADGE:

In addition to relatives of M.I.F. personnel, Mothers and Widows of all members of the forces (including the Citizen Military Forces) on continuous service who have been killed in action or have died of wounds or other causes whilst on service either in Australia or abroad or as the result of such service, will become eligible for the issue of the Mothers and Widows Badge.

5. GENERAL SERVICE BADGE:

The issue of the General Service Badge is to be discontinued for the present. Consideration of the question whether the issue of the badge will be resumed, and if so under what conditions, has been deferred.

6. RESERVED OCCUPATION AND MEDICALLY UNFIT BADGE:

The issue of the Reserved Occupation and Medically Unfit Badge is to be discontinued.

7. MEMBERS OF WOMEN'S AUXILIARY ORGANISATIONS PRESERVE RELATIVES, ETC:

The Returned from Active Service Badge, Female Relatives Badge and Mothers and Widows Badge is to be issued in respect of the personnel set out hereunder, under the same conditions as for members of the forces:-

1. Officially approved representatives of the recognised Philanthropic bodies:- Australian Red Cross Society, Australian Comforts Fund, Y.M.C.A., Salvation Army, Y.W.C.A., Official Press Correspondents, Official Photographers.

2. Members of the following Women's Auxiliary Organisations:-

Australian Army Nursing Service
Voluntary Aid Detachments
Australian Women's Army Service

8. RETURN OF BADGES PREVIOUSLY ISSUED:

The present holders of the General Service Badge, Reserved Occupation Badge and Medically Unfit Badge should not be compelled to surrender the badge except in so far as this is required by existing conditions which provide that a badge must be returned if a person ceases to have the qualifications by reason of which the badge was issued to him.

9. GENERAL:

In all other respects the conditions governing the issue of War Badges as specified in Military Board memorandum No.79394 dated 29th November 1940 will be observed.

The cancellation of authority for L of C Areas to raise Camp Hospitals as required and advice that all Camp Hospitals would, in future, appear on the O of B was contained in SM.9436 of 29 May, 42.

2. Appendix "A" attached hereto, sets out the Camp Hospitals approved and which have been added to the O of B, Allied Land Forces in Australia up to and including those provided for in SM.13103 of 14 July, 42.

3. The locations of these Camp Hospitals are given in this instance for identification purposes, but the units will in future be designated only by numbers and the L of C Sub-Areas in which located.

4. Any additional Camp Hospitals that may be required will be subject to prior approval of L H Q.

5. Only those Camp Hospitals with 30 beds or more will appear on the O of B, therefore, L of C Areas will review their requirements in the matter of Camp Hospitals having less than 30 beds and will submit to L H Q forthwith a list setting out the locations and number of beds at all such Camp Hospitals within their Area. If the aggregate number of beds in these minor Camp Hospitals combined in each L of C Area totals more than 30 beds, a new unit consolidating such minor Camp Hospitals will, after application has been made by the L of C Area and approval given by L H Q be placed on the O of B.

7. Changes of location of minor Camp Hospitals will not require to be advised to L H Q, but the aggregate number of beds authorised in the consolidating unit shall not be exceeded without the approval of L H Q.
