

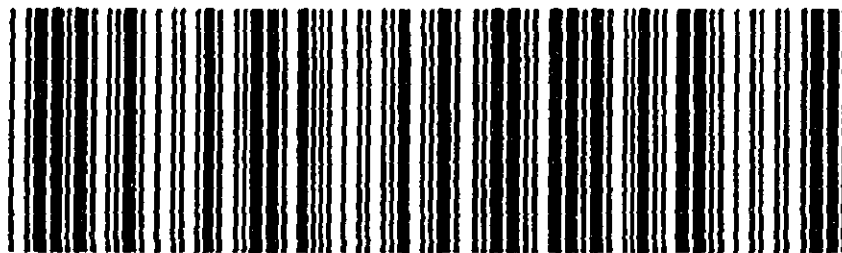

2nd ECHELON - FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

ADJUTANT-GENERAL

Further to previous submissions concerning the above, and to the approval of C.C.S. and L.C.A. to various matters arising therefrom, the whole question has been re-considered and the following matters are submitted.

2. The approval provides for 2nd Echelon to be part of the A.Gs. Staff and not a Service.

(a) It is assumed that this does not necessarily involve an amendment to the War Establishment, LHQ, to provide for the absorption of 2nd Echelon LHQ and of all Records Offices and detachments, and that the present procedure whereby each major component of the organisation operates on a separate W.E. will continue to apply. This assumption is supported by the approval given to the proposed 2nd Echelon LHQ W.E. and by British practice.

(b) It is further assumed that the decision that 2nd Echelon forms part of the A.Gs staff is not confined to 2nd Echelon LHQ but embraces the whole organisation, including Records Offices. The recommendations previously made laid considerable stress on the comprehensive use of the term "2nd Echelon", hence the above assumption, but this is at some variance with the actual advice signed by C.C.S. and L.C.A. in that the heading reads "Re-organisation of "A" Branch and 2nd Echelon LHQ".

3. Since the preparation of the earlier submissions, there has been received from 2nd Echelon GHQ (ME) considerable further data which indicates that within that organisation certain specific appointments only carry staff status and responsibility. Those appointments are restricted to those officers required to enunciate or directly implement GHQ policy, and officers charged with detailed but internal responsibilities are not classified as staff officers.

4. The question of a more appropriate title for the Records Office also arises. While anxious to stress the "Echelon" responsibilities as enunciated in F.S.R. Vol.I very definite benefits accrue on the "Home Records" side from retaining in some measure a reference to the general location of the office and it is submitted that requirements could best be met by re-naming the various Records Offices in some manner indicative of both the Field and Home responsibilities.

5. The following specific recommendations are submitted on the points raised:-

- (a) The entire 2nd Echelon organisation to be part of the A.Gs. staff for functional purposes and control; and
- (b) 2nd Echelon LHQ and the various major components to continue to operate on separate W.Es.; and

(c) Certain specified appointments only, within the Echelon organisation, to carry staff titles and status, these appointments and titles to be -

(d) Officer in Charge 2nd Echelon LHQ to be equivalent in status to a Staff Director and 2nd Echelon LHQ to be the equivalent of a Staff Directorate.

(e) Records Offices to be re-named on the following basis -

Q'land L of C Area Records Office
to be Queensland Echelon & Records

New South Wales L of C Area Records Office
to be N.S.W. Echelon & Records

(f) Officers in Charge the various "Echelon & Records" Offices to be restricted in the use of their staff capacity to the implementation of A.Gs. policy, responsibility for enunciating policy to such officers on Echelon matters to remain with O2E.

(g) O2E to be authorized to exercise direct command over the 2nd Echelon organisation.

(h) The Draft GROs herewith, giving effect to the approved Charter and to the matters raised herein (in anticipation of approval) are forwarded for your acceptance. The GRO concerning changes in nomenclature etc, and which will issue from the General Staff, provides for a specific reference to the A.G's Branch Order.

2nd ECHELON

PART I - GENERAL

The purpose of this Order is to define the status and enunciate the responsibilities of the 2nd Echelon organisation.

2. (a) The organisation as a whole comprises 2nd Echelon LHQ, together with the various components located throughout the Australian mainland, Tasmania and New Guinea, and such detachments as may be required from time to time for the proper discharge of 2nd Echelon functions.

(b) It may also include any other unit or detachment functioning or required to function as a 2nd Echelon in the field to any portion of the A.M.F., wherever located, subject to such specific directions as may issue on the relationship to exist between such unit or detachment and 2nd Echelon LHQ.

PART II - STATUS AND ORGANISATION

3. The 2nd Echelon organisation, comprised as in para 2 of this Order, constitutes an integral part of the staff of the Adjutant-General.

4. Without in any way limiting or restricting the responsibilities and powers thereby vested in the Adjutant-General in relation to the organisation as a whole, for functional purposes and for simplification of administration and control each major component will be organised as a separate entity with an appropriate War Establishment, and will be possessed of specific unit identity.

5. The immediate head of the organisation within the Staff of the Adjutant-General will be the Officer in Charge, 2nd Echelon LHQ, who, in addition to those responsibilities listed in PART III of this Order, will be the Commanding Officer of 2nd Echelon LHQ and will exercise general powers of control and administration in relation to the 2nd Echelon organisation.

6. The respective Officers in Charge of the various other components of the organisation will exercise all normal powers of command within their specific appointments.

7. The local administration of all components of the organisation, wherever situate, will be the responsibility of the Headquarters of the L of C Area concerned, or, where appropriate, of the Headquarters of the Force or other Command.

8. The responsibility for prescribing and enunciating all matters of 2nd Echelon policy and procedure is vested in LHQ only.

PART III - FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

9. The 2nd Echelon organisation will be responsible to the Adjutant-General, through the Officer in Charge, 2nd Echelon LHQ, for the following:-

A. RECORDS & CASUALTIES

(i) The custody and maintenance of the personal records of every member of the Force including the member's service and casualty sheet (AFs B.199(a) and B.103), medical records, enlistment data, wills and such other personal records as may be directed.

"Member of the Force" is to be interpreted as including all current serving members, (including prisoners of war), absentees, personnel reported missing, discharged members, or those reported killed or deceased from any cause.

(ii) The custody and maintenance of such personal records as may be required in respect of members of Philanthropic bodies and authorised press and photographic representatives serving with the Forces, civilians in certain areas, and of Empire or other Forces serving in Australia.

- (iii) The release of information relating to personal records, or the transfer of documents, to approved parties.
- (iv) The recording of casualties to members of the A.M.F. and of those referred to in sub-para (ii) above, and the dissemination to next of kin and other approved parties of suitable particulars of such casualties, including the preparation and issue, where necessary, of Certificates of Death or of Presumption of Death.
- (v) The preparation and dissemination of Routine Orders Part II.

B. ORGANISATION AND STATISTICS

(a) Provision of personnel.

- (i) The assessment and allocation to specified training or to duty of all newly enlisted personnel, or of personnel made available from re-organisations, disbandments, or by special direction, such allocation to be in accordance with priorities as prescribed from time to time. Assessment and allocation shall include full appreciation of the rank, mental, physical and technical or specialist qualifications of the personnel available.
- (ii) The detailed supervision of the strength and composition of all units in relation to War Establishments and the necessary action to correct or regularise any mal-distribution of personnel within an Arm or Service or within the A.M.F., in accordance with such policy directions as may be issued from time to time.

- (iii) The preparation and submission of appreciations, statistical or otherwise, and as required, of the manpower situation existing or anticipated, together with estimates of future requirements, based on staff planning forecasts.
- (iv) The allotment of and posting to units of reinforcement or other personnel, in accordance with authorised entitlements and such priorities as may be prescribed. This includes the provision of personnel for the raising of new units.

(b) Statistical.

The compilation, analysis, dissection and appreciation of statistics, including certain medical statistics, relating to manpower within the A.M.F., and the dissemination of such information in such manner as may be directed.

C. GENERAL MATTERS

- (i) Preparation and issue of directions for Records Procedure, including the method of compilation and distribution of "Personnel" returns.
- (ii) Preparation and issue of Discharge *and Statements of Service*, Certificates, and issue of Service Badges.
- (iii) Distribution of Female Relative's and Widows badges, Royal Messages of Condolence etc.
- (iv) Honors & Awards - notification to recipients and to next of kin, including extracts from citations and the consequential disposal of further pertinent documents.

- (v) Medals, Clasps, and M.I.D. emblems - verification of individual entitlement and where required, ultimate distribution.
- (vi) Distribution to commissioned Officers or to next of kin, of Forms of Commission.
- (vii) Provision of basic personal information to Commonwealth Statistician for national purposes.
- (viii) Registration of internees, enemy prisoners of war, and enemy's dead found on the battlefield, and the maintenance of personal records and statistics in respect of internees and enemy prisoners of war, and transmission of appropriate data to the Prisoners of War Information Bureau, and to other approved parties.
- (ix) Custody of unit documents and records not currently required.

PART IV - OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES & SPECIAL AUTHORITIES

10. The Officer in Charge, 2nd Echelon LHQ will be the deciding authority regarding all questions concerning the administration and application of "X" List procedure, and the responsible authority for the disposal of all available "X" List and unallotted personnel.

11. 2nd Echelon LHQ and all other components of the 2nd Echelon organisation are authorised to communicate direct with other Branches of the Staff, Heads of Services, Formation etc HQs, units or detachments, Government Departments and the public, on matters associated with the discharge of the functions enunciated in this Order.

12. Existing GROs or other Orders or directions wherein reference is made to the functions and responsibilities of the whole or part of the 2nd Echelon organisation will be read in conjunction with this Order.

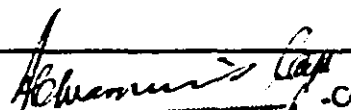

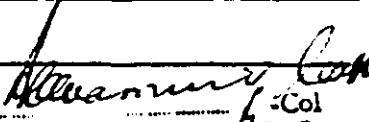

INJURIES TO MEMBERS OF THE FORCES - INVESTIGATING
 OFFICERS' REPORTS AND COURTS OF INQUIRY UNDER GRO
 A.392/43

DIRECTION NO. 78

1. Attention is invited to the provisions of the abovementioned GRO and in particular the amendment of 26 May 1944, initiated by this office to ensure that the "home" Records Office would receive two copies of all Investigating Officers' reports and/or courts of inquiry proceedings, thus providing for one copy to remain permanently with the member's records and for one copy to be made available to Repatriation authorities in appropriate cases.
2. The Records Office which receives the two copies of the AMF D.11, Investigating Officers' report and/or court of inquiry proceedings will, if it is not maintaining the personal records of the unit to which the member concerned belongs or belonged at the time of his death, forward such documents without delay to the Records Office which is maintaining such personal records.
3. The Records Office maintaining the personal records referred to in para 2 hereof will take the following action immediately on receipt of the copy documents:-
 - (i) Cause a suitable extract to be passed to the Personal Records Section for publication in Routine Orders Part II, of an entry in the manner provided in sub-para 93 or 152 of specimen Routine Orders Part II, issued with Direction for Records Procedure No. 76.
 - (ii) If such Records Office is not the "home" Records Office in relation to the member concerned forward both copies of the documents to the "home" Records Office.
4. The "home" Records Office will on receipt of the copy documents pass them to the Casualty Section for notation and any necessary action and will then file them in the MRS 3 with the medical documents of the member concerned.

- 2 -

One copy will be retained as a permanent record and in appropriate cases the other copy will be forwarded to the Repatriation Commission.

5. In appropriate cases the Casualty Section of the "home" Records Office will ensure that prompt action is taken pursuant to Direction for Records Procedure No.69 (Suicide Cases).

6. (a) If it appears to the Records Office maintaining the unit records that an inadequate report has been made by an Investigating Officer or Court of Inquiry or that an Investigating Officer has reported on a fatal casualty in breach of the GRO the matter should be immediately referred to the appropriate superior authority of the unit concerned.

(b) An instance of an inadequate report is that of a court making a report that a member died as a result of self-inflicted injuries but does not specify, or find in substance whether the injuries were intentionally, negligently or accidentally so inflicted.

(c) If any matter is referred back to superior authority one copy of the documents will be retained pending completion of correspondence on the matter and the other copy forwarded to the "home" Records Office with advice as to the action taken.

(d) Upon finalisation of any matters referred to superior authority the Records Office will, after taking the appropriate action under para 2(a) hereof forward all documents, including amended reports (if any) to the "home" Records Office.

7. (a) The procedure laid down in para 28 of the GRO and para 3 hereof applies to cases in which only one member is concerned in an Investigating Officer's report and/or a court of inquiry.

(b) Where more than one member is concerned in a report or inquiry the Records Office maintaining the unit records will ensure, by making additional copies if necessary, that each "home" Records Office concerned receives one copy of the documents.

(c) It will be the responsibility of each "home" Records Office to make sufficient further copies for filing with the records of each individual concerned.

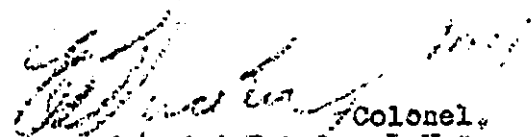
8. All copies of civil coronial inquiries which are received by any Records Office will be dealt with as provided in paras 2, 3 and 4 hereof.

9. (a) The procedure hereinbefore laid down will apply to Empire Forces attached to the A.M.F. whose "home" Records Office is, as provided in Direction for Records Procedure No.68, Vic. 1 of C Area Records Office.

(b) Upon termination of any such attachment or death of any member so attached, any documents pertaining to investigations or inquiries pursuant to the abovementioned GRO or any civil coronial inquiry, will be forwarded to this office for transmission to the appropriate authorities.

10. It is possible that documents relative to the inquiry into injuries to or death of personnel of Empire or Allied Forces not attached to the A.M.F. may be received by Records Offices and if any documents are so received they will be forwarded direct to this office for transmission to the appropriate authorities.

11. The necessity for the most prompt action under paras 2 and 3 hereof is stressed in order that the documents will reach the "home" Records Office with the minimum of delay.

1. With reference to L.H.Q. 59750 dated 3 May 44 (copy attached to Records Offices only) it is advised that consequent upon the policy enunciated in that memo. the following action will be taken by L. of C. Area Records Offices.

PERSONAL RECORDS.

2. (a) A R.O. Part II will be issued for each unit which has been placed on a reserve basis recording:-

- (i) the disposal of P.T.D. members in accordance with advice received; and
- (ii) the names of the P.T.D. members as "Ceased to perform P.T.D. consequent upon the unit being placed on a reserve basis".

(b) The issue of R.Os Part II for such units will thereupon cease, except that in the event of the death of a member, his being transferred to another unit or his discharge authorised, a Part II Order will be issued to promulgate the Casualty.

(c) The procedure for discharge where this is to be effected will be as laid down in Direction for Records Procedure No. 49 dated 17 Mar. 43.

STRENGTH RETURNS.

3. (a) The consolidated Strength as shown on the Weekly Strength Return will continue to be notified with the addition of an extra column to show those transferred to Reserve.

(b) The Return will then disclose:-

F.T.D.	P.T.D.	RESERVE
Staff	Others	

(c) In compiling the Weekly Strength Return due regard will be paid to any variations of the Reserve Strength brought about by casualties of the nature referred to in para.2(b) above.

4. L. of C. Area Records Offices will advise the units concerned that subsequent to their being placed on a reserve basis no further casualty or field returns will be submitted to the Records Office, with the exception of such Casualty Returns as may be required to notify casualties of the nature referred to in para.2(b) above.

VOLUNTEER DEFENCE CORPS - FUTURE POLICY

In view of the changed strategical situation in conformity with the policy laid down for the V.D.C. in SM 311 of 10 Jan. 44, further consideration has now been given to the future role of the Corps and it has been decided that:-

(a) The following portions of the Corps will be retained on an active basis:-

- (i) Units and sub-units allotted to Anti-Aircraft, Coast Artillery and Searchlight duties;
- (ii) Units charged with close protection of Fortress areas;
- (iii) All units North of 20° South latitude, except such inland sub-units thereof as may be recommended by First Aust. Army or 3 Aust. Corps to be placed on a reserve basis.

(b) All other inland and coastal units will be placed on a reserve basis with the exception of such sub-units as are providing personnel to man Anti-Aircraft, Coast Artillery and Searchlight defences.

2. It is desired that the above policy be fully implemented by 31 July, 1944.

3. The maximum establishment for units maintained on an active basis (inclusive of all P.T.S. personnel) will be in accordance with the following table:-

4. The conditions of service which will apply to those units placed on a reserve basis are as follow:-

- (a) For the time being .303 or .300 rifles will be held by members together with such web or leather equipment as is necessary for their use.
- (b) Ammunition will be allotted for the year 1944-5 on the basis of 100 rounds per member per annum.
- (c) All other equipment, training stores, ammunition, explosives, etc. will be withdrawn forthwith from sub-unit stores by Battalion HQ for return to Ordnance Depots as soon as possible and, in any case, not later than 31 Jul.44.
- (d) A limited number of voluntary parades (not more than one per month) may be approved for rifle practice.

Sub-units, particularly those which are located at places where a rifle club previously existed, are to be encouraged to remain the nucleus of any post-war rifle clubs reorganisation which may be approved in the future.

No limit will be placed on any additional voluntary activity which units or sub-units may desire to undertake, provided no expense to the Commonwealth is occasioned thereby and there is no requirement of additional FTD Staff.

- (e) Full-time duty staffs are to be reduced in the first place to 1 officer and 2 other ranks (1 as MT driver) per Battalion.
- (f) Battalion car (or truck) and driver will be withdrawn as soon as all equipment and stores have been returned to Ordnance Depot.
- (g) Headquarters of Groups (except Metropolitan and Fortress) will be disbanded entirely as soon as all stores of the Battalions within the Group have been despatched to Ordnance Depots.
- (h) Mobile Training Cadres to be disbanded as soon as practicable except where organised to instruct in AA, CA, SL etc. duties.

5. A statement is being issued by the Prime Minister as soon as possible indicating the adoption of the above general policy and the reasons for same, and expressing appreciation of the work performed in the past by those units which are now being placed on a reserve basis while, at the same time, affirming the necessity for those units which still remain active to continue to carry on their duties with the same enthusiasm as hitherto.

6. It is felt, however, to be desirable that members be given a more personal evidence of the high regard in which their work has been held generally by all ranks in other portions of the AMF and for this purpose a special parade is to be called at each sub-unit centre. As many as possible of such parades are to be attended by Corps and Group Commanders (and at the remainder senior officers will be detailed to represent them) so that they may express personal appreciation on behalf of the Commander-in-Chief of the work done in the past and explain as fully as

possible the reasons underlying the policy which has now been adopted.

7. Your recommendations are required as early as possible as to:-

- (a) The detailed organisation and establishment of part-time duty and full-time duty personnel for Active units within the maximum establishment indicated in para.3 above.
- (b) Any further suggestions in relation to the conditions of service, which are necessarily of a general nature, prescribed for Reserve units.
- (c) Any difficulties which may be foreseen in completing the action laid down within the time limit allowed.
- (d) Disposal of F.T.D. officers.
- (e) Any other relevant matters which you may desire to bring forward.

PRISONERS OF WAR - STATISTICS

1. With reference to LHQ memorandum 68535 (not to Records Offices) regarding information required by War Office in relation to enemy prisoners of war, it is advised that the monthly returns furnished by Camp Commandants PW Camps to L of C Area Records Offices are in future to be compiled in triplicate for each nationality in accordance with the attached pro-forma, as at 0600 hrs on the 12th of each month commencing 12th July 1944.

2. (a) It will be noted that Column 1 (classification) requires a sub-division to be made in respect of Naval and Air Force prisoners to account for submarine and flying personnel respectively as distinct from the general terms "Naval" and "Air Force".

(b) "Flying personnel" should include all Air Force personnel who were actively engaged in flying duties or who were qualified or fit for such duties at the time of capture.

(c) Personnel qualified for any form of air crew duty who are believed to have been permanently grounded for any reason should be included in the classification "Air Force (others)".

3. (a) Column 2 "Strength" is to show the total strength Officers and C.Rs.

(b) Column 3 will show PW newly captured and received in camps since date of last return and will include also those captured by Empire or Allied Forces and held by the Commonwealth as Detaining Power. The names of all such new PW will be shown on a nominal roll and set forth according to the categories mentioned in para 2(a) hereof and will accompany the returns.

(c) Column 4 to show PW received from other holding countries since last return.

(d) Columns 5, 6 and 7 are self explanatory.

4. (a) With regard to Column 8, category (f) "Unemployables" -

- (1) "Politically Intransigent", it is advised that this designation is applied to pro-Fascist or malcontent PW whom it may be undesirable to employ on security or other grounds.

(b) The category (g) "Numbers for whom no employment can be found" is advised by War Office as being the interpretation to be placed on the term "Will move to un-employment" referred to in para 4(g) of LHQ memorandum 68535 above referred to.

(c) The distinction to be observed between those to be included under the categories "(f), (iii)" and "(g)" shown in Column 8 of the pro-forma is -

- (i) Category "(f) (iii)" will show all those PW who by reason of physical or mental disabilities are unable to undertake any useful work for the time being.
- (ii) Category "(g)" will cover those whose capacity for employment is limited to occupations for which no demand exists.

5. (a) Two copies of each return will be despatched to reach the Records Office for the L of C Area in which the PW Camp is located not later than the 14th of each month and one copy retained on the camp file.

(b) Records Offices will forward one copy to reach 2nd Echelon LHQ (PW Section) not later than the 18th of each month.

(c) It is of the utmost importance for the returns to be rendered promptly in order that the figures may be consolidated and transmitted to London on the 18th of each month.
