

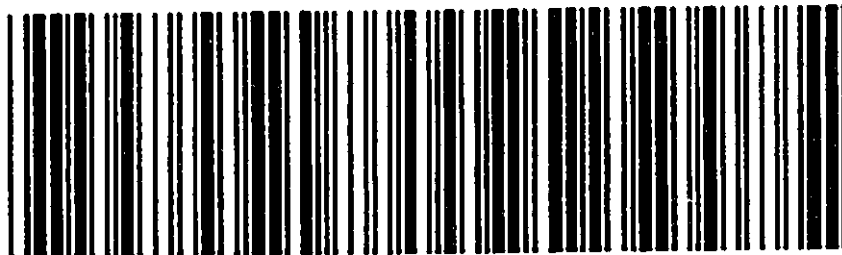

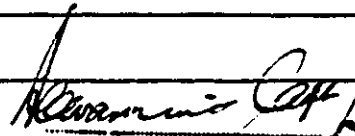

ECHELON GENERAL OFFICE INSTRUCTION NO. 2
RE ORGANIZATION OF PROCEED. RE AT R.R. & G.D.D.s.

1. (a) Further to 2nd Echelon LHQ memorandum 036143 of 14 Jun 44, to Records Offices only, enclosing copies of LHQ 258963 of 6 Jun 44, and replies from the various Records Offices, it is desired to advise that it is expected that instructions for the reorganization of R.R. & G.D.D.s on parallel lines will be issued shortly.

(b) In view of this fact, it is desired that the procedure adopted by all Records Liaison staffs at G.D.D.s be on a uniform basis.

2. Accordingly, it is directed that the following procedure, which is designed to effect the quickest possible disposal of personnel from G.D.D.s consistent with efficiency and economical use of personnel be instituted in each G.D.D. in respect of records procedure to be undertaken at such Depots.

3. (a) The Records Liaison staff will be located in Reception Coy. After interview by the Reception Clerks and completion of the soldier's "Action Card" which will be similar, except for certain minor amendments, to the "Basic Card" attached to LHQ 258963 of 6 Jun 44, the incoming soldier will pass to the Records Liaison staff.

(b) Among the alterations to be made to the "Action Card" mentioned in sub para (a) hereof will be the provision of a portion to be completed by the Records Liaison Officer and the Allocation Officer.

This will contain the following spaces, viz:-

- (i) Disposal ...
- (ii) Reinforcement Order No. ...
Serial ...
- (iii) Remarks ...
- (iv) Signature - Records Liaison Officer ...
- (v) Allocation Officer's Remarks ...
- (vi) Re-allocation from ...
Duty ...
- (vii) Signature - Allocation Officer ...

(a) Action taken by the Records Liaison Officer will depend on the category of the soldier, and the varying procedure is detailed hereunder in accordance with the several classes of personnel which may enter the G.D.D.

"X" List fit for return to Unit:

4. (a) If a soldier is eligible to return to parent unit and such unit is still on the O.C.B., and if he is not to be granted leave in accordance with para 41 of G.M.O. 898/43, the space for disposal on the "Action Card" will be completed "R.T.U. (Name of Unit)" together with the current Reinforcement Order No., Serial No. and Date and the signature of the member of the Records Liaison Staff, in the spaces provided.

(b) The soldier's Unit, Army number, rank, name and duty will then be entered on the draft copy of the current "X" List Reinforcement Order.

(c)(i) At the end of each day or other convenient period, the Reinforcement Order will be closed off, typed, signed and distributed.

(ii) The typing, etc. of the Reinforcement Order, should, if practicable, be completed at the G.D.D., but if suitable arrangements cannot be made for this to be done, the draft order may be forwarded to the Records Office for typing and issue.

(iii) It will be noted that the authority for the G.D.D. to arrange movement of the soldier concerned will be endorsed on the "Action Card" and the Reinforcement Order serves as a formal confirmation of this authority and advice to formations and other units concerned.

(d) In any instance where the "X" List soldier's former unit has been deleted from the O.C.B., Records Liaison Staff will not direct disposal without reference to the Maintenance Section of Records Office for instructions.

(e) Where leave under para 41 of G.M.O. 898/43 is to be taken by the "X" List soldier prior to return to parent unit, the remarks space will be entered "To return to Records Liaison Officer on completion of leave". In such cases a record will be maintained showing the following particulars:-

(f) Upon return from leave, the soldier concerned will be marked "C" in the record, the disposal portion of the "Action Card" completed and the Reinforcement Order issued.

Where any doubt exists in regard to the correct disposal of a soldier, it will be either held pending enquiries, if it appears that "he has" or "he has not" been sent to his parent unit. The decision given in the remarks space should be brought before the Records Liaison Officer again on a day's time, or such longer period as is considered will be required to complete the enquiries.

It is essential, therefore, that such a soldier should be interviewed and on the basis of suitable questioning and examination of available records the correct parent unit determined. It is not possible to lay down the exact form the verification or enquiries should

Also, as this will be a matter of experience and may vary in each individual case.

Personnel for Re-posting.

5. (a) Personnel for re-posting either under authority of the provisions of G.R.O. 415/43 or other specific instruction such as will occur in the case of disbanded units, will consist of two categories, viz:-

- (i) Those who can be re-posted in their present arm and trade or duty, or "B" class non-specialists who can be cross posted to another arm and employed without conversion training or in appointments which do not require special attributes.
- (ii) Those whose re-posting requires change of arm and/or trade or duty (except "B" class non-specialists mentioned in (i) above) or special attributes and difficult or problem cases.

(b) The posting of personnel in category (i) above may be made immediately by the Records Liaison Officer.

(c) Personnel in category (ii) of sub-para (a) hereof will be referred to the Allocation Officer for re-allocation to a new arm and/or trade or duty commensurate with their aptitude, disability, if any, previous army service and civil occupation. In these cases the Records Liaison Officer will, in the Remarks space of the "Action Card", indicate that the soldier is "to be interviewed by Allocation Officer and returned to R.L.O. for posting."

(d) The Allocation Officer will refer personnel for re-allocation to the Psychology Officer, Medical Officers or for Trade Testing, as and when considered necessary. If conversion training is necessary before posting to a unit can be effected, the Allocation Officer will, as specified for "Allocation Officer's Remarks" on the "Action Card" insert "Conversion training required."

(e) In case of personnel in category (i) in sub-para (a) hereof, and personnel in category (ii) after their return from the Allocation Officer, the Records Liaison Officer will complete the disposal space on the "Action Card" with the name of the unit to which the soldier is to be posted, or reinforcement training unit or A.R.D. to which he is to be drafted, whichever is applicable, and the reinforcement order number, serial and date. The soldier's army number, rank, name, duty (trade, specialist or non-specialist classification) and unit to which he or she is to be posted or drafted, will then be entered on the draft copy of the Reinforcement Order.

(f) The "Re-posting" Reinforcement Order will be closed off daily in a similar manner to the "X" list Order vide para 4 (c) hereof.

(g) (i) In order that the Records Liaison Officer should be in the position to determine postings for personnel in either category (i) or category (ii) of sub-para (a) hereof, it will be necessary for him to be kept informed of the requirements of units in the Area and the current priorities, and in addition of any special requirements for other areas. This should cover the bulk of the personnel who become available for re-posting. In the case of personnel who cannot be posted in accordance with such requirements, the Records Liaison Officer should request advice from the Maintenance Section of the Records Office as to required disposal.

(ii) If the details of postings made by the Records Liaison Officer at G.D.D. are promptly noted by the Maintenance Section, duplication of postings should not occur.

(h) In any case of personnel who are to receive leave before being re-posted, the remarks space of the "Action Card" should be endorsed "To return to R.L.O. or completion of leave".

(i) A Register in similar form to that provided for in para 4(e) above will be maintained in respect of personnel who have been directed by the Allocation Officer or who are to return for disposal direction given above.

(k) In the cases where "Action Cards" have been noted to the effect that personnel will return to the Records Liaison Officer, it is to be understood that whether the soldier reports in person to the Records Liaison Officer or not is a matter of local arrangement. It may be more convenient for the Liaison Officer to visit the relative section of the disposal force, or arrangements may be made for the "Action Cards" to be supplied to the Liaison Officer for the purpose of indicating posting. Such procedure will be dependent on local arrangement with G.O., G.O.D.

Personnel for leave without pay

6. (a) Personnel returning from L.W.O.P. in excess of 28 days will be interviewed by the Records Liaison Staff after their return from leave and if not medically reclassified will be disposed of in the same manner as provided for herein for "X" List personnel.

(b) Those whose medical examination results in a re-classification will be dealt with in a similar manner to personnel for repeating if they are not eligible for R.L.O.

Personnel returning from abroad including Repatriated

into home of War?

7. (a) These personnel will be dealt with in accordance with the disposal procedure applicable, whether they be "X" List or for re-assignment, subject to any specific G.H.Q. instructions which may be issued from time to time.

(b) With regard to personnel repatriated or returned to Australia from enemy captivity, attention is directed to G.H.Q. S45782 of 30 May 44 requiring every effort be made to deal with such personnel as expeditiously as possible. Disposal will be in accordance with the directions contained in that instruction and GPO 220/44.

Miscellaneous personnel (for medical boarding, schools and courses, etc.)

8. (a) These personnel will also be dealt with in accordance with the procedure applicable to their category.

(b) In the case of personnel for medical boarding, arrangements will be made for such as are not discharged to be returned to the Records Liaison Officer for disposal direction when the result of their boarding is known.

9. The Records Liaison Staff will check nominal rolls or draft (P.A.F.A232) with Reinforcement Orders issued on G.O.D.'s to ensure that such orders are implemented, and will follow up all outstanding cases. In order that this may be effected, arrangements should be made for the Records copy of A232 to be handed to the Liaison Officer for forwarding to the Records Office, after this check is completed.

11. It is appreciated that the directions contained herein are more applicable to the larger G.D.D.s - i.e., Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne. Nevertheless it is desired that they be applied in principle by all G.D.D. Liaison staffs with such suitable modifications as will suit local conditions in the smaller G.D.D.s.

12. The amendments to WEs notified in para 5 of this office memorandum C6597 of 10 Mar 45, detailed the staff required for Records Liaison duties at G.D.D.s in Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne and it is considered that this staff should be sufficient. However, the comments of Records Offices concerned and any recommendations it is desired to submit in the matter will be appreciated after a reasonable trial has been given to the system herein outlined.

13. It is appreciated that the full introduction of the system is contingent upon the completion of the proposed re-organization of R.R. & G.D.D.s including the provision of the "Action Card." However it is desired that the present system be re-organized forthwith to conform as closely as possible to the system outlined herein and it is suggested that the provision of slips remedied to contain the information mentioned in para 3 (b) hereof and pinned to the soldier's papers, may serve as a temporary expedient pending the introduction of the "Action Card."

14. Please advise if any difficulties occur in the implementation of these instructions.

SUMMARY AWARDS - CANCELLATION OF.

1. Attention is invited to A.M.R.S. C.431(1) (as amended by Serial No.43) which provides (inter alia) for the cancellation by the authorities therein mentioned of the finding and award of a C.O. or the award only as the case may be.
2. Although the finding of a C.O. is not recorded as such in any of the relevant documents, e.g., charge report, offence report or Routine Orders Part II, the awarding of punishment implies a finding of guilty in respect of the offence recorded.
3. Care will be taken in giving effect in Routine Orders Part II to a direction that an award be cancelled and the relevant entry expunged that such portion of the entry relating to punishment only be deleted, leaving the offence and any automatic forfeiture consequential on the implied finding of guilty to stand.
4. Publication of entries recording cancellations in respect of C.Os' findings and awards will be effected as follows, e.g.

(i) Where finding and award are cancelled:-

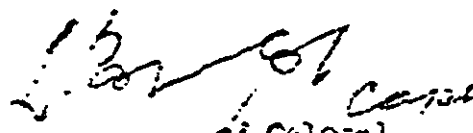
