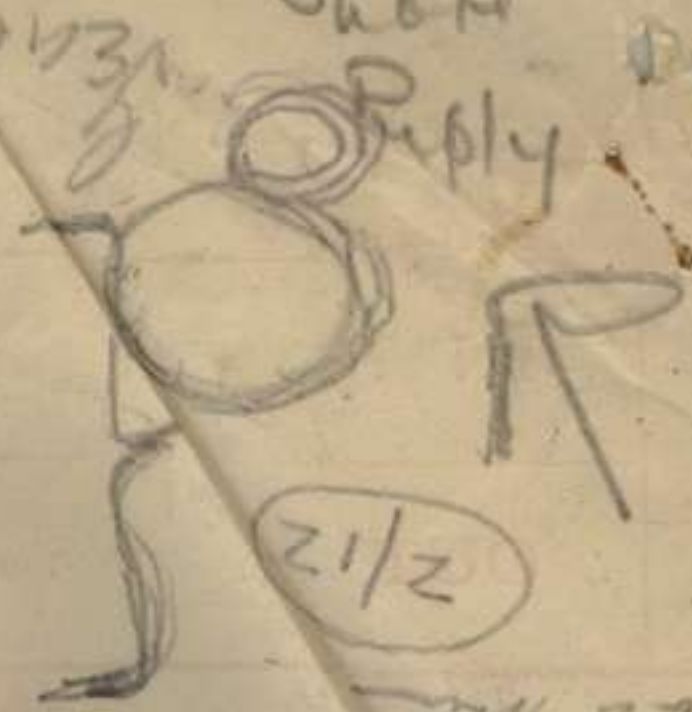

Present Movements On 20 Jan 300 tps of different units left GIRUWA with 15 HMG, 40 LMG, Mortars, grenade throwers, plenty of amm and 3 days rations, to move westwards, and assemble 6 ri (1 ri equals 2.44 mls) west of the KUMUSI River on the coast.
Most of the men were footsore, had bad legs through immersion etc. They were walking by day and moonlight, sleeping at intervals.

Unit PW had been absent from JAPAN over three years. Went to CHINA in 73 Regt. After 1 year became 173 Regt.

Personalities Comd 173 Regt - Maj-Gen ADACHI - probably did not come to NEW GUINEA. Lt-Col YAMAUCHI - comd Bn. Capt KOYAMA killed.

Bombardments Feared mortars, aeroplane bombing, arty, in that order.

Captured GIRUWA area 1300 hrs 24 Jan 43.

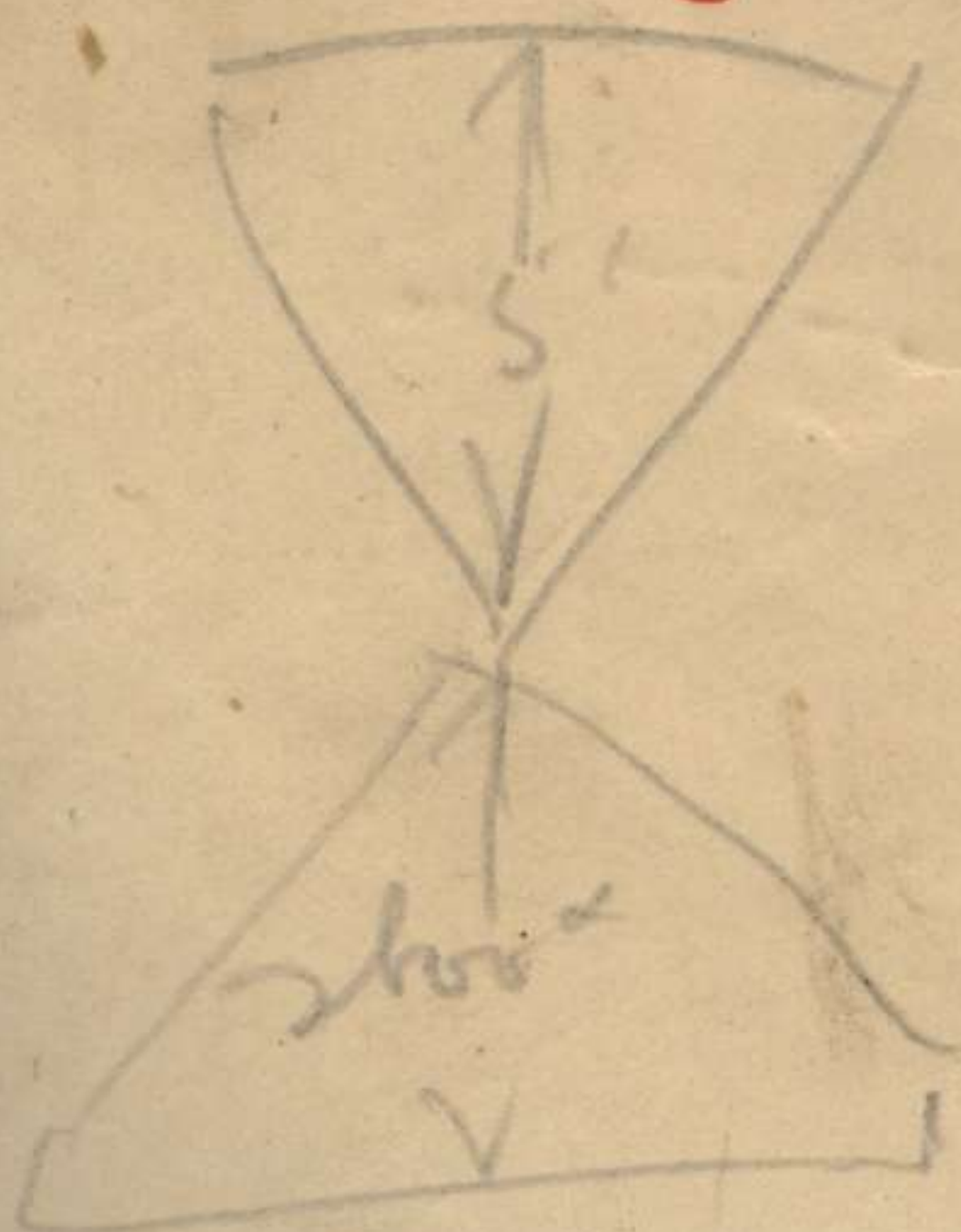

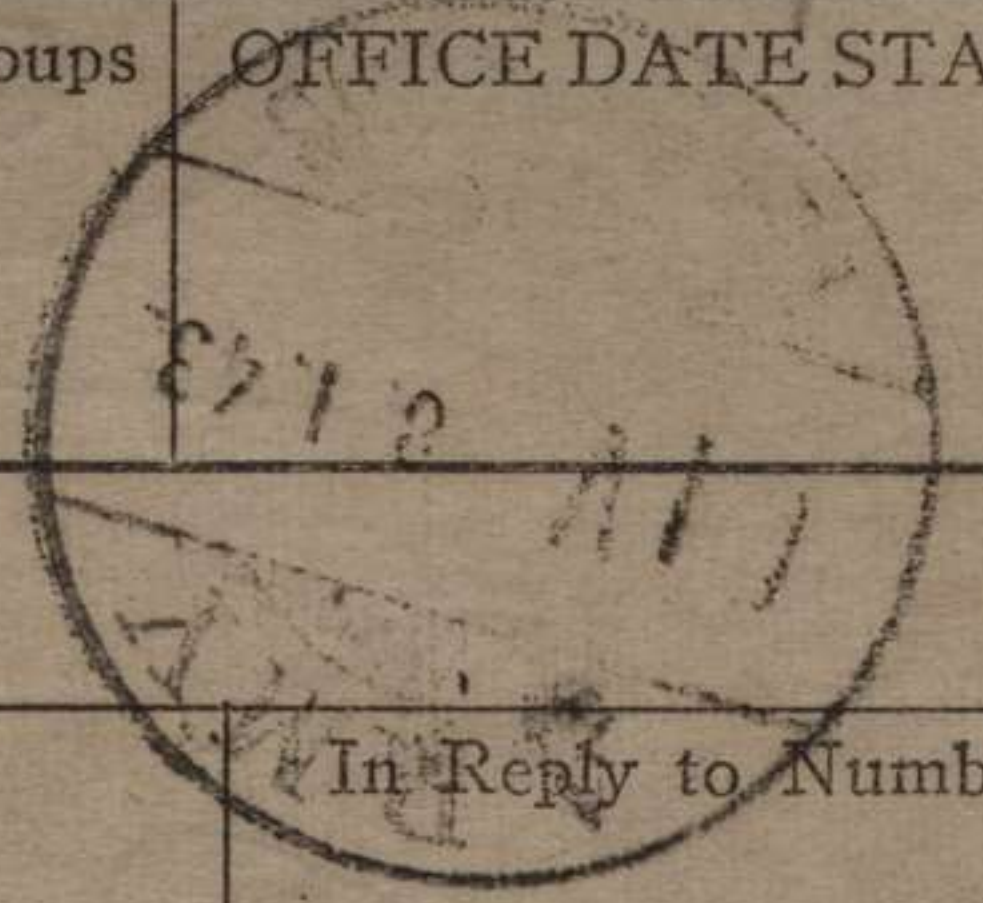

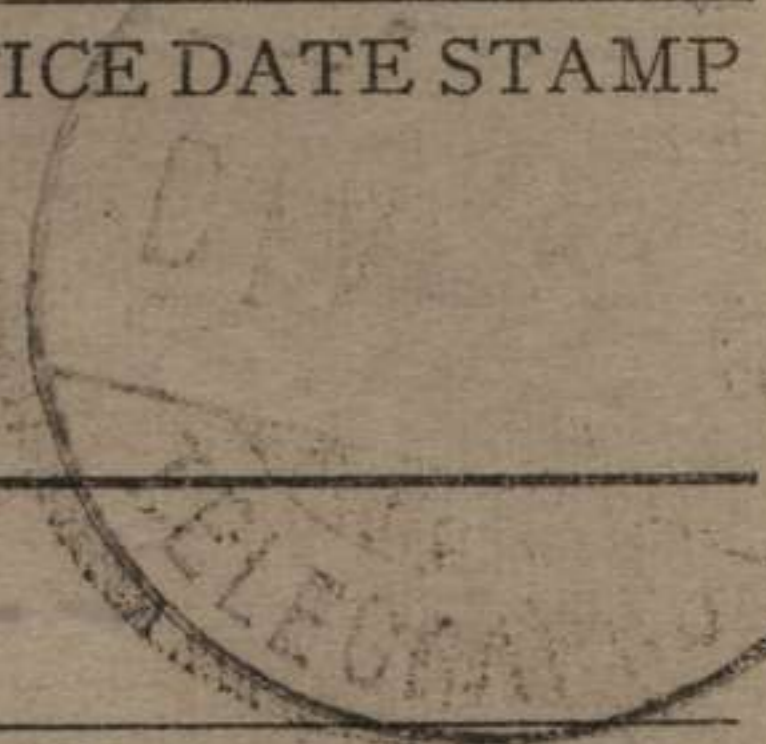
