The Forward move of FDLd, 2/13 Bn, as per 00 No.10. The time schedule for the move fwd was shortened to two nights instead of four. This was accomplised, but engineering stores were not available to completely wire the front. This however will be done as soon as wire is made available. B. Coy on left moved forward, dug in and occupied new posns on night 10/11 Jun. A Coy and C Coy did likewise on night 11/12 Jun. Throughout the whole day of 10 Jun one sec of B Coy occupied old diggings previously discovered by patrols approx 200x fwd of the ten Coy FDLs.

Booby Traps had been reported in area to be occupied by left pl B Coy and Engrs had gone fwd covered by a patrol on night -9/10 Jun to investigate and remove them. They removed approx 60 of various types on night 9/10 Jun. Booby Traps took many forms. Mr Pits and vacated weapon pits contained quantities of ITALIAN hand grenades, Bither loosely scattered or attached to pieces of flat board. These grenades prepared to explode when disturbed. Explosives attached to trip wiresy attached to taut wires which when cut caused explosion, attached to or concealed in everyday articles, such as ration tins, loaves of bread,

articles of clothing and some prepared so that they exploded when stepped on. Technical details of these traps may be obtained from Engrs. The Engrs were not able to clear all booby traps from area on night 9/10 Jun but continued their work on night 10/11 Jun assisted by our Pnr Pl. The exact number of traps removed is not known but it was considerable and many traps have been left fwd of our posns to render area equally inaccessable to enemy. On night 9/10 Jun we suffered one OR killed and one Sgt injured by the explosion of one of these booby traps.

Time of arrival of evening meal governed the timing of the programme. Rations arrived at 2215 hrs and by the time Engrs with their covering party had declared the area safe for working it was 6130 hrs, before digging commenced. A wiring party from the Pnr Pl wired the posns as the digging progressed.

Work was held up at intervals by heavy enemy MC fire and an enemy Mortar attempted to range on the working party. Work was interrupted but as no casualties resulted the work was pushed fwd sometimes under fire. Weapon Pits were dug for the whole Coy to a depth of approx 41, in some cases were linked by crawl trenches and the whole Coy Front with the exception of 100 yds was wired by 0430 hrs.

Wiring Party and Engrs returned at 0430 hrs and posns were occupied complete with three days reserve water, rations, arms, amn and egpt by 0500. Normal shelling, sniping and machine gunning was experienced day 11 Jun.

Coy had moved fwd mean distance of 350-400 yds.

L/T established as digging commenced.

The same procedure was adopted by A and C Coys on night 11/12 Jun. Engr representatives moved fwd with the covering party in the event of unreported booby traps being discovered. With A Coy Engrs had specific task of investigating and, if necessary, and clearing minefield previously reported by our patrols.

Parties went fwd as soon as it became dark to locate and spitlock posns before moon-rise so that working parties could move aut and commence digging with minimum movement. Arrival of rations and hot evening meal again governed commencement of operations.

A Coy's rations arrived at 2300 hrs and covering party consisting of one pl supplied by reserve coy at 0050 hrs. Wiring party supplied by Pnr Pl arrived at 0130 hrs.

The fwd move of the left pl was severely hampered by MG and Mortar fire .

Very heavy MG fire also opened on B Coy but this was neutralised by fire from B Coy's Brens. Digging commenced at 0200 hrs.

At 0230 hrs work on the left flank of A Coy was interrupted by MG and some Mortar fire killing one OR of the covering party and one OR Engrs. Our Mortar had previously registered on targets in area and fire was brought to bear, silencing the enemy.

Contact was made with the 2/1 Pnr Bn on the right and C Coy on the left.

Wiring party covered main portions of the front with wire but appears spent the last hour of darkness bringing fwd water, rations and amn.

Posns dug to approx depth of 4ft and all tps other than A Coy out of area by 0430 hrs.

Cow moved fwd on general front 400 yds.

L/T established as digging commenced.

The fwd move of C Coy was commenced by fwd secs who moved up with their own covering parties at 2400 hrs reced the new posns and commenced digging. The main body of the Coy together with covering party of one pl from reserve Coy and det of Engrs moved fwd at 0100 hrs.

One sec of left pl adapted and occupied posn previously held by 2/24Bn and reported by us in Patrol Report for Wight 10/11 Jun. This posn was already wired and thereby saved muchwork. The right of C Coy progressed without incident but on the left an area of thickly laid gooby traps was discovered which area the Engrs proceeded to clear. As the whring party consisting of Pnr Pl personnel and some attached AASC personnel was moving fwd carrying wire stores a very heavy explosion occurred killing three men and injuring four. The excat cause of the explosion is not known but either one of the party contacted a trip wire from a booby trap or stepped on some form of contact mine. This explosion attracted the attention of the ENEXX enemy who fired occasional bursts from MGs in general direction of left pl. One OR was wounded but notwithstanding this fire the digging and wiring was kept going.

Covering and wiring parties left by 0445 hrs. Posns dug to depth of 4 ft and completely stocked by 0500 hrs.

C Coy adv from 300 yds on left to 500 yds on right.

L/T established as digging commenced.

At daylight enemy was very active and MG and Mortar fire with some sniping was directed at the new posns.

C Coy also reported enemy arty shelled old posn area.

The fire was answered in kind and at 0800 enemy fire from fwd posns slackened considerably. Intermittent shelling continues - one casualty after daylight.

GENERAL. The fwd move shortens the Bn Front by approx 600x giving closer touch with enemy and an improved field of fire.

The shortening of the line enables the front to be held with a Coy dispos-

Sgt BROWNING of D Coy was, immediately prior to dusk on 4 April during the fight to the left of the road, a short distance behind the anti-tank ditch ER REGIMA.

In his vicinity he saw Lieut ROSS with a party of men, he estimated at about 7, but he said could easily have been nine. Just on dark when enemy infantry were coming over the top of the Pass in front, other enemy infantry numbering a couple of hundred came in from the right flank and over-ran the group of men. He saw them completely surrounded and surrender and they were taken into the anti-tank ditch. A far as he was aware no man in the group was killed.

Lieut MacDONALD, accompanied by Cpl EVANS, Pte BARRY (orderly), Pte WHITEHEAD (driver) and Pte CRAW A.C. (fitter) left C Coy at BARCE at approx 0845 hrs on 3 Apr 41 with instructions to report to Bn HQ. The party arrived at Bn HQ safely.

Before leaving Bn HQ on their return journey to BARCE, Lieut MacDONALD collected a 30-cwt truck B Echelon driven by Pte MURRAY V?R. The party was last seen by Capt HANDLEY of D Coy who issued certain instructions to Lieut MacDONALD.

Before leaving D Coy at approx 1730 hrs on 3 Apr 41 Lieut MacDONALD inquired the way via the rear road. It was known that he had earlier intended to take the coast road. As no one can be found who can give any further information it is not known by which road the party actually travelled.

#### CASUALTIES.

Extract from report to Offr i/c Records, 2 Echelon, AIF dated 22 May 41.

"NX17368 Pte JENKINS states that enemy action forced Lieut PERSRSON's platoon to move south instead of east during the action at night on 4 April. Capt FRASER and Sgt ROBBINS, who had been captured, escaped and moved with the platoon.

On the following day, after having broken contact with the enemy, the pl moved back into the hills and then moved in a south-easterly direction. They continued in this direction for 3 days, moving by night. Pte JENKINS has no idea as to the exact distance they travelled. On the second night Pte WARD B.L., who was suffering from bad feet, dropped out. A search was made but he was not seen again. On the fourth day Cpl BRAY R.D., Ptes TANNER H and SPOONER A.D. left the main part better chance of getting through as a small party.

On the night of the fifth day the main party camped in a cave near a well in the vicinity of which was an overturned ration truck containing a considerable quantity of bully beef. The next day Capt.FRASER and Lieut. PETERSON left the others to make a recce in the direction of BARCE. Six days were allowed to elapse and then as these officers had not returned the party decided to proceed on their way.

From the cave they moved in a NNE direction with the idea of making for DERNA as they were led to believe, by the natives, that this town was still held by our forces. Each man carried 8 tins of bully beef. A fair supply of water was to be found along the route.

On the third night after leaving the cave they were joined by four English soldiers who had escaped from MERSA BREGA.

On the sixth day from the cave or the eighteenth from REGIMA, they came upon a road, which they believed to be the DERNA RD, as they had been told by the natives that the town of CIRRENE was situated a little further back to the west. Along the road to the east was another town which would probably be GIOVANNI BERTA, On making a recce of the road it was found to be in enemy hands. In view of this they changed their direction to south-east, in which direction they kept for 2 days. The country then became so desolate that they decided to head back NNE.

On the 22nd day out from REGIMA they left Pte.McKEOWN at a native village as he had a bad leg and could not travel any further. The following day Pte JENKINS and two of the English soldiers left the party to move independently. They gained the impression that the main party intended to follow the road, which they thought was a back road into TOBRUK. The last seen of the main party by Pte JENKINS was on the following day when his party waited to inform them the whereabouts of a good water supply. No enemy had been sighted on this road but the following night one truck passed through the village at which they had stopped. That same night they met a camel train on its way out from the TOBRUK area and the natives told them that they had been travelling for six days. It was at this point that they came to the village where they met ABDULLA ABU HAMAD who, after they had rested for six days, guided them into TOBRUK.

The attached appendix shows approx where the various members of the original party were last seen by PTE JENKINS.
